GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Proclamation under section 2 of the Primary Produce Safety Act 2011

This proclamation fixes 1 February 2015 as the day on which the remaining provisions of the *Primary Produce Safety Act 2011* commence.

(2) Primary Produce Safety (Egg) Regulations 2014

These regulations prescribe, for the purpose of the Primary Produce Safety Act 2011 -

(a) the food safety scheme in respect of eggs and egg products; and

- (b) the accreditation requirements in respect of the production of eggs and egg products; and
- (c) the fees payable in respect of accreditation under the egg food safety scheme; and

(d) other miscellaneous matters in relation to eggs and egg products.

(3) Primary Produce Safety (Meat and Poultry) Regulations 2014

These regulations prescribe, for the purposes of the Primary Produce Safety Act 2011 -

- (a) the food safety scheme in respect of poultry meat, meat and meat products; and
- (b) the accreditation requirements in respect of the production of poultry meat, meat and meat products; and
- (c) the fees payable in respect of accreditation under the meat and poultry food safety scheme; and
- (d) other miscellaneous matters in relation to poultry, meat and meat products.

TASMANIAN GOVERNMENT GAZETTE

(4) Primary Produce Safety (Pet Food) Regulations 2014

These regulations prescribe, for the purposes of the Primary Produce Safety Act 2011 -

- (a) the food safety scheme in respect of pet food; and
- (b) the accreditation requirements in respect of the production of pet food; and
- (c) the fees payable in respect of accreditation under the pet food food safety scheme; and
- (d) other miscellaneous matters in relation to pet food.

(5) Animal (Brands and Movement) Amendment Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the Animal (Brands and Movement) Regulations 2014 by updating certain references to reflect the commencement of the Primary Produce Safety Act 2011, in relation to meat and poultry, and the consequent repeal of the Meat Hygiene Act 1985.
