GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) (Exemption) Notice 2014*

This notice, made under the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Regulations 2001* –

- (a) exempts, for 3 years and for specified purposes, certain vehicles and combinations from the load limit applying to Mud Walls Secondary Road between Tea Tree Secondary Road and the Midland Highway; and
- (b) revokes the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) (Exemption) Notice 2011*.
