VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC ACT 1999

Annual Adjustment Factor for the Financial Year 2014-15

I, M.T. (RENE) HIDDING in accordance with clause 6 of Schedule 2 to the *Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999*, determine the annual adjustment factor for the financial year commencing on 1 July 2014 to be 1.3%.

The annual adjustment factor is used, in accordance with Schedule 2 to the *Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999*, in the calculation of the tax payable for a heavy vehicle.

The annual adjustment factor is based on the formula that is determined by the National Transport Commission, established under the *National Transport Commission Act 2003* of the Commonwealth, in respect of the financial year commencing on 1 July 2014 and reflects changes in the expenditure of state and local governments on roads and expected changes in road use by heavy vehicles.
