#### **RULES PUBLICATION ACT 1953**

NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of the Rules Publication Act 1953, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:---

## GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Animal Farming (Registration) Regulations 2015

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe emus, a fee and a condition of registration for the purpose of the Animal Farming (Registration) Act 1994; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the Animal Farming (Registration) Regulations 2005 under section 11 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.

#### (2) Fisheries (Infringement Notices) Amendment Regulations 2015

These regulations amend the *Fisheries (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2011* by rescinding the provision and schedule relating to infringement notice penalties prescribed for the purposes of the *Fisheries Rules 2009*, as such penalties are, by virtue of the *Fisheries Amendment Rules 2015*, specified in the *Fisheries Rules 2009*.

#### (3) Fisheries (Penalties) Amendment Regulations 2015

These regulations amend the Fisheries (Penalties) Regulations 2011 by -

(a) updating certain legislative references; and

(b) clarifying that an offence under the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* may be taken into account in determining a second offence, or a third offence, in relation to a fisheries regulation or fisheries rule.

#### (4) Fisheries Amendment Rules 2015

These rules amend the Fisheries Rules 2009 by -

- (a) revising certain provisions consequent on the commencement of the Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2015; and
- (b) revising the circumstances in which a receipt must be given for the sale of certain fish; and
- (c) prohibiting the sale of certain fish caught recreationally; and
- (d) prescribing offences in respect of which infringement notices may be served, and specifying the infringement notice penalties for those offences.
