NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of the *Rules Publication Act 1953*, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:—

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT of THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Ambulance Service (Paramedic) Amendment Regulations 2015*

These regulations amend the *Ambulance Service (Paramedic) Regulations 2014* by rescinding the provision that would have caused those regulations to expire on 30 June 2015.

(2) *Education Regulations 2015*

These regulations –

- (a) provide for certain matters in relation to an application for registration of a school; and
- (b) provide for the Registration Board to be notified of certain changes in relation to registered schools; and
- (c) prescribe the proportional rate for the purposes of determining school grants; and
- (d) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Education Regulations 2005* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(3) *Health (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2015*

These regulations amend the *Health (Fees) Regulations 2007* by increasing the fees payable by non-nursing-home-type patients in accordance with national consumer price index movements.
