GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT of THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Amendment Regulations 2016

These regulations amend the Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Regulations 2010 -

- (a) in relation to the transportation of explosives; and
- (b) to reflect changes made to the National Transport Commission (Mode Legislation Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road or Rail) Regulations; and
- (c) to make other minor amendments.

(2) Food Amendment Regulations 2016

These regulations amend the Food Regulations 2012 by -

- (a) correcting a referencing anomaly which inadvertently removed certain requirements on the sale of eggs; and
- (b) clarifying the applicable requirements on the sale of eggs in certain circumstances; and
- (c) restricting the exemption that allows the sale of unstamped eggs to eggs produced as part of home egg production.

(3) Residential Building Work Contracts and Dispute Resolution Regulations 2016

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe certain residential buildings not to be residential buildings for the purposes of the *Residential Building Work Contracts and Dispute Resolution Act 2016*; and
- (b) prescribe solar panels, satellite dishes and rooftop wind turbines to be part of a residential building for the purposes of that Act; and
- (c) set an amount as the maximum that may be charged as a progress payment under that Act; and
- (d) prescribe certain fees and infringement notices and penalties.
