GENERAL AUTHORITY FOR THE IMPORTATION OF BEES AND BEE PRODUCTS

I, Roderick Andrewartha, Chief Veterinary Officer, hereby issue a General Authority for the importation of European Honey Bees and Bee Products.

This General Authority is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. Queen bees and escorts must be sourced from an apiary that has an active surveillance and management plan in place for the control of small hive beetle (Aethina tumida).
- 2. All cages used for the transportation of queen bees must be new wooden cages constructed in a manner to ensure small hive beetle cannot gain entry; with one side of the cage covered by a mesh with holes less than 2mm x 2mm, allowing good visibility of the bees and candy within the cage.
- 3. The queen bee cages must be inspected by the apiarist immediately prior to loading the queen and escort bees and found to be free of small hive beetle.
- 4. The queen bee and escorts must be hand caught and inspected by the apiarist at the time they are placed in the new queen bee cage and found to be free of small hive beetle.
- Once loaded, queen bee cages must be stored away from bee hives, packaged bees or used bee equipment and transported separate from bee hives, packaged bees or used bee equipment.
- 6. The outer packaging of any consignment of queen bees must have a visible statement with letters in 28 point font or larger on a contrasting background indicating that the package contains live bees.
- On arrival in Tasmania the packaging and queen cages must be inspected for evidence of small hive beetle by an Inspector and must not be released unless the inspection determines that no small hive beetle are present.
- If small hive beetle is detected the whole consignment must be held and either destroyed under quarantine supervision or sealed and returned to the state of origin.
- 9. The receiving Tasmanian apiarist must inspect the queens for small hive beetle prior to placing them in a hive. If there is any evidence of small hive beetle Inspector notified. Bees or queen cages with evidence of small hive beetles must not be placed in a hive.
- 10. Substances produced or collected by bees, other than bees wax and honey comb, may be imported without

restriction.

- 11. Bees wax must be melted and cooled prior to importation.
- 12. Honey Comb must not be imported into Tasmania.
- 13. The consignor of the bees or bee products in the state or territory of origin must provide a written declaration certifying that, to the best of their knowledge, all of the above conditions have been met.
- 14. A Government Inspector or other authorized person in the state or territory of origin must certify in writing that after due enquiry, they have no reason to doubt the 'owner declaration' required by condition 13.
- 15. Written declarations and certifications referred to in conditions 13 and 14 above must be in a form approved by the Chief Veterinary Officer, and must be presented to an inspector when the bees or bee products arrive in Tasmania.

This general authority takes effect on 1 January 2017.

RULE 9 OF THE FISHERIES (ABALONE) RULES 2009

Pursuant to the powers under the *Fisheries (Abalone) Rules* 2009 ("the Rules") that were delegated to the Director (Marine Resources) on 19 August 2015 by the Minister acting pursuant to section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management* Act 1995 ("the Act"):

1. under rule 9(1) of the Rules 1 determine that the dates of closing of State waters of the commercial blacklip abalone fishery in **State waters off the east coast of Tasmania** to the activities of the take and possession of blacklip abalone (*Haliotis rubra*) are as follow:

from 1 January 2017 to 31 March 2017 inclusive; and

 under rule 9(3) of the Rules 1 also determine that, for the period specified in this notice, if the holder of a fishing licence (abalone dive) on a fishing trip takes blacklip abalone (Haliotis rubra) in State waters outside State waters off the east coast of Tasmania then State waters off the east coast of Tasmania are closed to the activities of entering the water by swimming or diving;

This Notice may be cited as the "Occupational Licensing Owner Builder Insurance Notice 2016".

2. Purpose of this Notice

This Notice specifies the insurance required to be held by holders of An Owner Builder Permit under the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005*.

3. Authorising provision

This Notice is made under section 29F(1) of the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005*.

4. Commencement

This Notice takes effect on the date of its publication.

5. Application of anticipatory provisions of the Acts Interpretation Act 1931

Section 11 of the Acts Interpretation Act 1931 applies to this

Notice.

6. Application of Notice

- This notice applies to the holder of an Owner Builder Permit granted pursuant to section 29D(1)(a) of the Act.
- (2) The holder of an Owner Builder Permit to which this Notice applies is required to be covered by the type and amount of insurance as specified by this Notice.

7. Overview of the required insurance

- (1) The holder of an Owner Builder Permit in relation to the building work project to which the Owner Builder Permit was granted –
- (a) must be covered by insurance that indemnifies the owner builder permit holder for any liability in respect of that work that the owner builder permit holder is required to be indemnified for by Part 2; and
- (b) must be indemnified by that insurance for the amount required by Part 2.
- (c) The insurance is required to be held prior to the commencement of any building work and is to continue until a Certificate of Completion (building work) is granted.

PART 2 - LIABILITY AND AMOUNT TO BE COVERED

8. Liability that must be covered and the amount of insurance required for prescribed work

- a) The holder of an Owner Builder Permit must have a policy to provide indemnity in respect of all claims which the Owner Builder Permit holder becomes legally liable to pay for compensation (excluding punitive or exemplary damages) in respect of personal injury or property damage caused by an occurrence in connection with building work carried out or managed by the holder.
- b) The policy is to include construction liability cover for damage to existing property where the owner builder permit holder has physical or legal control of premises.

Amount and Period of Insurance

- a) The policy can limit indemnity for any one claim during any one period of insurance to not less than \$5 million.
- b) The policy shall include in addition to the limit of indemnity, payment of the costs and expenses incurred by the insured with the consent of the insurer in defending or settling any claim and in respect of any one claim the policy may limit this to 20% of the limit of indemnity.
- c) The policy may provide for a greater insurance cover than that required by this Notice.
- d) It is not necessary that the insurance be provided by one policy only, or that the insurance be provided by one insurer only, provided that this Notice is complied with.

9. Transitional provision

A public liability insurance policy that was current prior to this Notice taking effect, that substantially complies with Part 2 of this Notice, is taken to comply with the requirements of this Notice.

DETERMINATION 2016

I, DALE EDWARD WEBSTER, Administrator of Occupational Licensing, make the following Determination for the purpose of sections 30 and 31 of the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005*

1.Short title

This Determination may be cited as the Occupational Licensing (Building Services Work) Determination 2016.

2.Commencement

This Determination will commence on the date of its publication in the Gazette.

3.Interpretation

In this Determination:

"Act" means the Occupational Licensing Act 2005.

"Administrator" has the same meaning as section 3 of the Act

"Building Services Provider" has the same meaning as section 3 of the Act

"Licensed Entity" has the same meaning as section 3 of the Act;

"Licensed Person", of a licensed entity, has the same meaning as section 3 of the Act

"Permit Authority" has the same meaning as section 4 of the *Building Act 2016*.

4. Application of anticipatory provisions of the Acts *Interpretation Act 1931*

Section 11 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1931* applies to this Determination.

5. Objects of this Determination

This Determination is to determine the:

- classes and scopes of Building Services Providers work for the purposes of issuing Building Services Providers licences; and
- 2) minimum qualifications and competence of Building Services Providers for the issue of a licence; and
- 3) to make specific provisions regarding the licensing of Building Services Providers:
 - (a) that are Licensed Entities; or
 - (b) for the category of Permit Authority.

6. Adoption of the Scheme for the Accreditation of Building Practitioners 2008

- a) The Scheme for the Accreditation of Building Practitioners 2008 (as Amended) is adopted for the purposes of licensing of Building Services Providers under the Act.
- b) Notwithstanding clause a), the requirement in the scheme to provide, on application and renewal, a Statement of Financial Capacity signed by an appropriately qualified accountant is not adopted and therefore does not apply.
- c) Clauses 7 and 8 of this Determination are determined to be an addendum to that Scheme.

7. Licensed Entities' Insurance

A licensed building services provider that is a Licensed Entity must hold the minimum level of insurance cover as provided in the "Ministerial Insurance Order Required Insurance for Building Practitioners 2008" (as amended) that is relevant to the category and scope of work performed by that licensed building services provider.

8. Requirements for Permit Authority category

- (a) Continuing Professional Development (CPD) reqirements
- i. Part 6 of the Scheme for the Accreditation of Building Practitioners 2008 (as amended) applies to a building services provider in the category of Permit Authority.
- Required CPD activities for a licensed Permit Authority equates to 12 points per year or 36 points over a three year period.

(b) Insurance requirements

Part A of the "Ministerial Insurance Order Required Insurance for Building Practitioners 2008 (as amended) applies to a building services provider in the category of Permit Authority. DALE WEBSTER Administrator, Occupational Licensing.
