- from 14 September 2016 to 31 December 2016, inclusive;

where: "State waters off the coast of King Island" is defined to mean: the area of State waters bounded in the north by the line of latitude 39° 30' 36.48" South, bounded in the south by the line of latitude 40° 15' 35.60" South, bounded in the east by the line of longitude 144° 11' 42.76" East, and bounded in the west by the line of longitude 143° 43' 44.91" East.

The holder of a fishing licence (abalone dive) can not on a fishing trip enter the water by swimming or diving in both an open and a closed part of the fishery regarding the same species.

Any expression used in this public notice having a particular meaning under the Act or the Rules has the same meaning in this public notice as it has in the Act or the Rules.

- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the Marine Safety (Misuse of Alcohol) Regulations 2006 under section 11 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.

(2) Legal Profession (Barristers) Rules 2016

These rules prescribe a range of legal practice matters for Tasmanian barristers, including pupillage requirements, and they also –

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
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
