Emergency Management

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACT 2006 DIRECTIONS FOR THE CLOSURE OF NATIONAL PARKS AND RESERVES

In the exercise of the powers conferred by me under Section 40 of the *Emergency Management Act 2006* and pursuant to clauses 1(1)(b) and 1(1)(k) of Schedule 1 to the Act, I hereby:

- 1. Close all parks and reserves that are managed by the Director of National Parks and Wildlife under the *National Parks and Reserves Management Act 2002*, namely:
 - National Parks
 - ii. State Reserves
 - iii. Nature Reserves
 - iv. Game Reserves
 - v. Conservation Areas
 - vi. Nature Recreation Areas
 - vii. Regional Reserves and
 - viii. Historic Sites.
- Close Wellington Park as defined in the Wellington Park Act 1993.
- 3. Close all Future Potential Production Forest Land as defined in the *Forestry (Rebuilding the Forest Industry) Act 2014*.
- 4. Prohibit any person or vehicle from entering any lands which fall within Paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 ('the Lands").

Direction 4 does not apply to:

- Members of the Tasmania Police Service, Tasmania Fire Service, Tasmania Ambulance Service or the State Emergency Service whilst acting in the course of their duties;
- (ii) Authorised officers as defined in the *National Parks* and *Reserves Management Act 2002* whilst acting in the course of their duties;
- (iii) Persons undertaking construction or maintenance work on the Lands on behalf of the State government, the Hobart City Council, the Glenorchy City Council, the Wellington Trust, TasNetworks, TasWater, Broadcast Australia or WINTV.
- (iv) Primary producers who need to enter the Lands for the purposes of their operations or to ensure the welfare of livestock, plant, equipment and products;
- (v) Persons lawfully operating businesses on the Lands which do not involve any direct contact with members of the public;
- (vi) Persons who ordinarily have the legal authority to occupy or traverse the Lands for the purposes of essential maintenance, security or as a place of residence;
- (vii) Persons who have no alternative route to access their freehold or leasehold land, other than traversing the Lands via an existing access route;
- (viii) Residents of Fern Tree traversing that section of the Pipeline Track running between the Fern Tree Park on Huon Road and Clegg Road, Fern Tree; or
- (ix) Persons, or classes of persons, granted exemptions by the State Controller.

These directions take effect immediately and will continue until further notice.
