LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995 FISHERIES (SCALLOP) RULES 2010

NOTICE - DATES OF OPENING AND CLOSING OF THE NON - COMMERCIAL SCALLOP FISHERY

- I, Tim Baker, Acting Secretary of the Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment, acting pursuant to a delegation from the Minister for Primary Industries and Water made on 12 November 2018 and acting pursuant to section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act), hereby:
- (1) Determine under rule 11 of the *Fisheries (Scallop) Rules 2010*, (the Rules) the dates of the closed season for all State waters for the **non-commercial scallop fishery** is as follows:
 - closed season from the date this notice is published in the Gazette until 31 July 2020.

The closed season for the non-commercial scallop fishery for 2020 has been implemented to reflect the Covid19 situation in Tasmania. The non-commercial fishery includes fishing activities undertaken by holders of a fishing licence (recreational scallop) and Aboriginal persons engaged in Aboriginal activities.
