PROCLAMATION

I, PROFESSOR THE HONOURABLE KATE WARNER, Companion of the Order of Australia, Governor in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, in pursuance of section 19(4) of the *Constitution Act 1934* and with reference to section 8 of the *COVID-19 Disease Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No.2) 2020*, the Premier having been notified by the Director of Public Health that he is of the opinion that there is no longer a significant risk to public health that would make it undesirable to hold the 2020 election, appoint 1 August 2020 as the date on which a poll is to be held in respect of the periodical elections of members of the Legislative Council to be held in 2020.

Further to its appointment of polling places of 18 December 2019 (gazetted on 4 March 2020), the Tasmanian Electoral Commission gives notice that, in accordance with section 92 and 93 of the *Electoral Act 2004*, it has appointed or terminated the ordinary, mobile and pre-poll polling places listed below for the divisions of Huon and Rosevears. These changes have been made to address COVID-19 social distancing requirements.

Note that polling places listed have been appointed/terminated for both divisions and that the headings only indicate the divisions in which the polling places are located.
