



Bayside City Council has prepared Amendment L8 to the Bayside Planning Scheme, Local Section.

- The CSO has to be acceptable to ATSI individuals and communities. ATSI people who require the assistance of a CSO are in an extremely vulnerable position and distressing circumstances i.e. being held by the police. For this and the foregoing reasons the duties of these positions will be able to be performed most effectively by ATSI people. The reassurance provided by the presence of a supportive indigenous person can make an enormous difference to the outcome of the ATSI person's arrest and their subsequent wellbeing and access to justice.
- VALS recognise the extreme disadvantage suffered by ATSI people in gaining employment within the sector. It encourages ATSI people to apply for training and staff development opportunities and to make application for vacant positions. The employment of ATSI people in these CSO positions will help to redress this disadvantage.






