# **Gas Industry Act 1994**

## DIRECTION UNDER PART 6A OF THE GAS **INDUSTRY ACT 1994**

To further ensure the safe and sure supply of gas, I, DAVID KNIPE, Chief Executive Officer of VICTORIAN ENERGY NETWORKS CORPORATION pursuant to an instrument of delegation of 25 September 1998 from Alan R Stockdale being the Minister responsible for the Gas Industry Act 1994 (the Act) and in exercise of the powers under section 62G of the Act. DIRECT:

- (i) all consumers of natural gas in Victoria (other than hospitals, aged and infirm residential institutions, laundries servicing these institutions as specified in the Attachment marked "A", and the entities, institutions and residences specified in the Attachment marked "B") until further notice:
  - to immediately cease the use of natural gas;
  - to turn off all natural gas appliances and meters; and
  - not turn on any gas meter; and
- (ii) ENERGY 21 PTY LTD, KINETIK ENERGY PTY LTD, IKON ENERGY PTY LTD, STRATUS NETWORKS PTY LTD, MULTINET GAS PTY LTD, WESTAR PTY LTD, GASCOR. TRANSMISSION **PIPELINES** AUSTRALIA PTY LTD, CFA, STATE EMERGENCY SERVICES, VICTORIA POLICE and their servants, agents and persons authorised to act on their behalf, to stop the flow of natural gas to all consumers of natural gas in Victoria (other than hospitals, aged and infirm residential institutions, servicing these institutions as specified in the Attachment marked "A", and the entities, institutions and residences specified in the Attachment marked "B") and to do any matters or things in connection with, or incidental to, stopping the flow of natural gas to all consumers (other than hospitals, aged and infirm residential institutions,

laundries servicing these institutions and residences as specified in the Attachment marked "A", and the entities, institutions residences specified in Attachment marked "B") including entering any land, building or structure.

This Direction under Part 6A of the Gas Industry Act 1994 does not apply to consumers in the towns of Hamilton, Warrnambool, Portland and Cobden.

This Direction takes effect at and from 9:15 pm on 30 September 1998 and on this Direction taking effect the Direction given by me dated 26 September 1998 which took effect at and from 10:15 pm on 26 September 1998 pursuant to an instrument of delegation of 25 September 1998 from Alan R Stockdale being Minister responsible for the Gas Industry Act 1994, will expire and cease to have effect.

## ATTACHMENT B

- Hostels, disability facilities, community care units, supported residential services, each of which accommodates persons with physical disabilities, physical or mental illness, or infirmity and where the continued restriction of natural gas will pose significant hardship to those persons.
- 2 The usual place of residence of persons with physical disabilities, physical or mental illness, or infirmity provided that a medical officer of the Ministry of Health has advised that it is necessary that such person's usual place of residence be supplied with natural gas.
- 3. CSL Limited and any of its associated or related entities providing blood or related products
