Gas Industry Act 1994

DIRECTION UNDER PART 6A OF THE GAS INDUSTRY ACT 1994

In order to facilitate the resumption of gas supply for the State of Victoria, the State anticipates that limited quantities of gas of uncertain quality and quantity may be injected into the principal transmission system from or around 1 October 1998. To ensure the safe and sure supply of gas for the State of Victoria by making provision for the burning of such gas, I, HARRY DE JONG, pursuant to an instrument of delegation of 1 October 1998 from Alan R Stockdale, Minister responsible for the **Gas Industry Act 1994** (the "Act") in the exercise of powers under section 62G of the Act **HEREBY DIRECT**:

- Energy 21 Pty Ltd, Kinetik Energy Pty Ltd and Ikon Energy Pty Ltd to accept and GASCOR to accept and supply to Generation Victoria such quantities of gas as are available from the Longford gas plant;
- Transmission Pipelines Australia Pty Ltd to accept and Victorian Energy Networks Corporation to accept and transport gas to Jeeralang power station;
- Generation Victoria to use gas supplied by GASCOR for the purposes of operating the Jeeralang power station.

This direction takes effect at 8.00 pm on 1 October 1998, and is effective until the Director of Gas Safety instructs GASCOR in writing that testing of gas is to cease.

Gas Industry Act 1994

DIRECTION UNDER PART 6A OF THE GAS INDUSTRY ACT 1994

To ensure the safe and sure supply of gas, I, HARRY DE JONG, pursuant to an instrument of delegation of 1 October 1998 from Alan R Stockdale being the Minister responsible for the **Gas Industry Act 1994** (the "Act"), and in exercise of the powers under section 62G of the Act, hereby **REVOKE** the following direction:

A direction by David Knipe, Chief Executive Officer of Victorian Energy Networks Corporation dated 28 September 1998 and published in the Victorian Government Gazette No. S102 dated Monday, 28 September 1998, being a Direction given under Part 6A of the Act, and relating to the provision of tempered liquefied petroleum gas ("TLPG") in Horsham and Colac.

This Revocation takes effect at and from 5.00pm on 1 October 1998.

Furthermore, in order to ensure the safe and sure supply of gas, I hereby **DIRECT**:

1. Westar Pty Ltd and its servants, agents and persons authorised to act on its behalf to effect the reconnection of consumers of TLPG in Horsham and Colac in a safe and orderly manner, and to do any matters or things in connection with or incidental to effecting the reconnection of TLPG to all such consumers including entering any land, building or structure;
2. Kinetik Energy Pty Ltd and its servants, agents and persons authorised to act on its behalf, as soon as can safely and surely be done following the reconnection of consumers of TLPG in Horsham and Colac, to permit and facilitate the flow and supply of TLPG to such consumers, and to do any matters or things in connection with or incidental to facilitating the flow and supply of TLPG to such consumers including entering any land, building or structure;
3. all consumers of TLPG in Horsham and Colac **not** to turn on any TLPG meter or appliance without any such TLPG meter or appliance having first been reconnected to the TLPG gas supply system by Westar Pty Ltd or its servants, agents or persons authorised to act on its behalf.

This Direction takes effect at and from 5.00pm 1 October 1998.
