MELBOURNE CRICKET GROUND (OPERATION OF FLOODLIGHTS) ORDER NO. 5/1998

I, Marie Tehan, Minister for Conservation and Land Management, make the following Order:

Dated 5 November 1998.

1. Objectives

The objectives of this Order are to -

- (a) specify the days and times during which the floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground may be operated; and
- (b) specify the purposes for which the floodlights may be operated on those days; and
- (c) make provision in relation to vehicle entry into the Yarra Park Reserve.

2. Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 3 of the Melbourne Cricket Ground Act 1984.

3. Floodlights may be operated on certain days at certain times and for certain purposes

The floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground may be operated -

- (a) for the purpose of conducting any activity on the arena at the Melbourne Cricket Ground between 10.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. on any day, including that specified in sub-clauses (b) and (c); and
- (b) for the purpose of playing cricket matches on the arena at any time after 8.00 p.m. on the following days -

8 January 1999:

15 January 1999:

19 January 1999;

12 February 1999;

13 February 1999;

14 February 1999;

15 February 1999; and

- (c) for the purposes of conducting the "Hey Hey It's Saturday Show" on the arena at any time after 8.00 p.m. on 7 November 1998; and
- (d) for the purpose of aligning, testing, commissioning or repairing of the floodlights, between 8.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. on any day.

4. Yarra Park Reserve - Entry of Vehicles

On any day on which the floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground are permitted to be used for the purposes specified in clause 3(b) and (c), vehicular traffic is not permitted to enter into the Yarra Park Reserve by way of Vale Street after 5.00 p.m.
