FISHERIES (SCALLOP-OCEAN FISHERY) (CLOSED SEASON) NOTICE NO. 4/1998

1. Title

This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Scallop-Ocean Fishery) (Closed Season) Notice No. 4/1998.

2. Objective

The objective of this Notice is to fix a closed season on the taking of scallops from Victorian waters.

3. Authorising provision

This Notice is made under sections 67 and 152 of the **Fisheries Act 1995**.

4. Commencement

This Notice comes into operation on 7 December 1998.

5. Closed Season

A person must not use a dredge for taking scallops from Victorian waters during the period commencing on 7 December 1998 and ending on 31 May 1999.

Penalty: 100 penalty units or imprisonment for 6 months or both.
