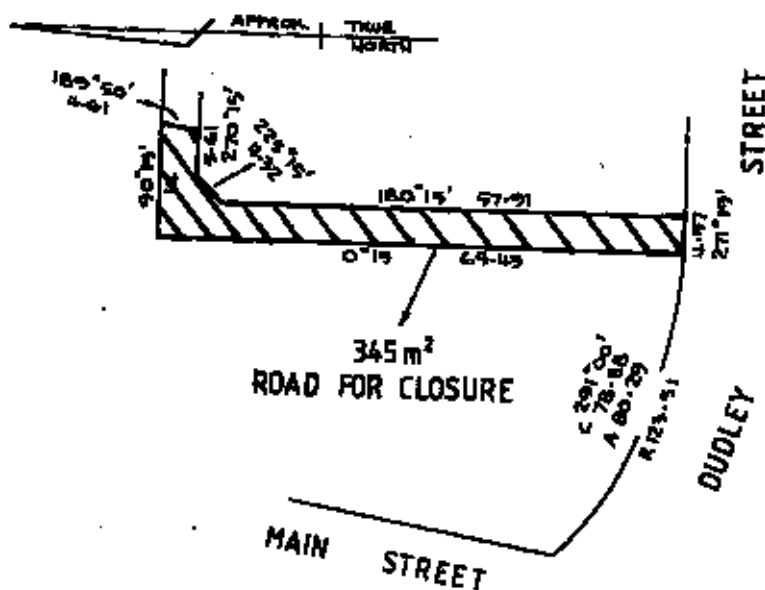

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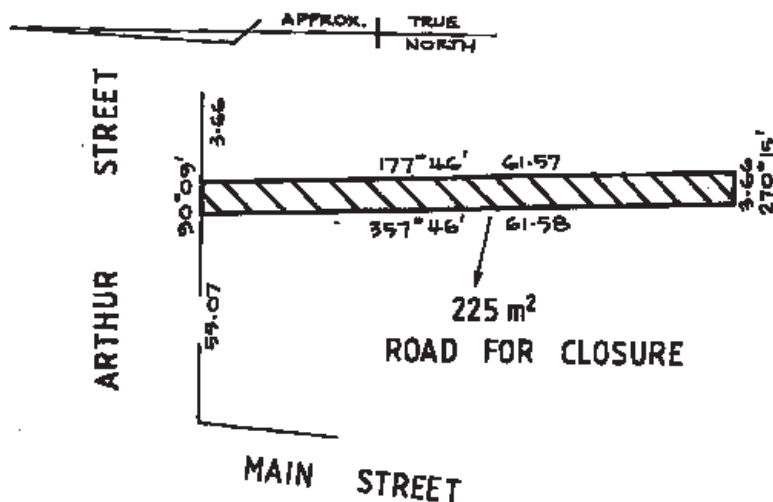

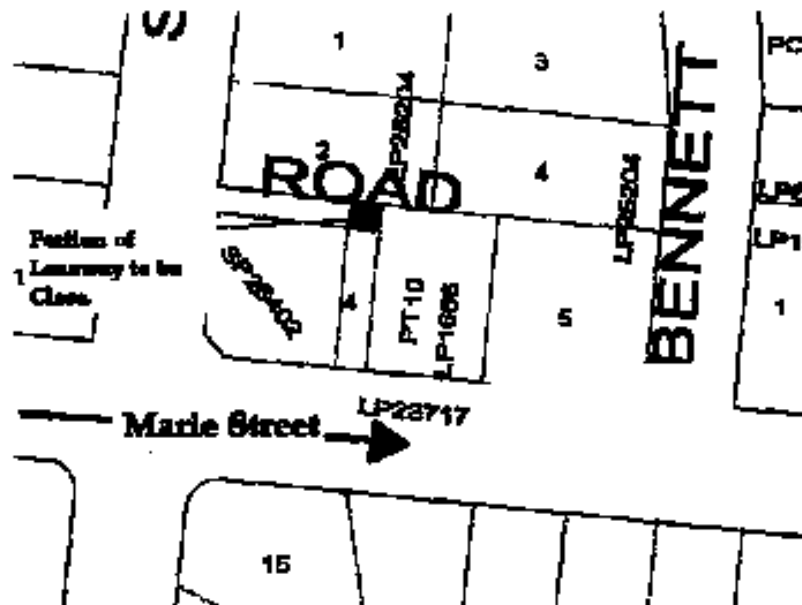

  - (2) are secondary school graduates, or equivalent;
  - (3) are proficient in spoken English;
  - (4) are capable of fully participating in the program as evidenced by the satisfactory completion of a physical;
  - (5) have been personally interviewed, in English, by an organisational representative; and
  - (6) have successfully passed a background investigation that includes verification of school, three, non-family related personal and employment references, a personality profile and a criminal record check or its recognised equivalent.

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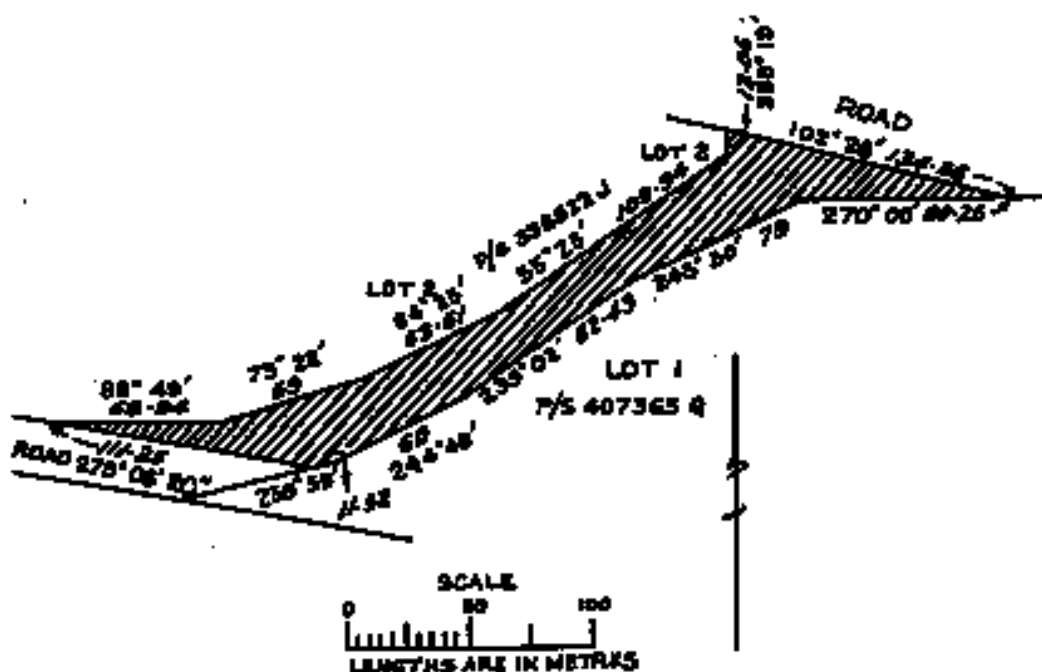
