## Casino Control Act 1991

### VICTORIAN CASINO AND GAMING AUTHORITY

#### Notice of Approval of Amendment

#### Amendment L313

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment L313 to the Melbourne Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment inserts a new Exempt Proposal under Clause 222 (Part 2 - Central City Development Area) which provides for the development of the site situated at 451-507 Little Lonsdale Street, 480-502 Lonsdale Street, 458-468 Lonsdale Street, 240-278 William Street, known as the former Peter MacCallum Hospital, the former ABC studios and other buildings for the purposes of demolition of buildings and works.
