Melbourne City Link Act 1995

DIVESTING OF LAND

The Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister for Planning and Local Government (being the Minister administering the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995**) and the Minister for Transport (being the Minister administering the provisions of the **Transport Act 1983** under which the Public Transport Corporation is established), under section 31(1) of the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995** divests from the Public Transport Corporation the area of 490m² shown diagonally hatched and the area of 95m² shown cross hatched on the plan numbered LEGL./97-297 lodged in the Central Plan Office.


SCHEDULE 11 CLAUSE 4

Designation of Tow-Away Areas

Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989** provides that a Council may move or impound any vehicle that is causing an unlawful obstruction or that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a "tow-away area"), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a fee up to the amount of the fee set for the purposes of Clause 3(1) (c).

For the purposes of that provision, I, Geoff Craige, Minister for Roads and Ports, designate the area depicted by hatching on the plan under this text, including all parts of the roads on the perimeter of that area, to be a tow-away area.

This instrument takes effect at 12.01 a.m. on Thursday 5 March 1998 and expires at 11.59 p.m. on Sunday 8 March 1998.
