**EXPLANATORY REPORT**

This Amendment has been prepared by Brimbank City Council and proposes to amend the Local Section of the Brimbank Planning Scheme. The Department of Natural Resources and Environment have requested the Amendment.

The Amendment proposes to rezone land bounded by Suspension Street, Forrest Street, North Street and Yallourn Street, Ardeer from a Reserved Living Zone to Public Open Space Reservation. The site is rectangular in shape and has an overall area of approximately 16,236m<sup>2</sup> with a frontage to Suspension Street of approximately 198 metres.

The site was formerly operated as a battery recycling plant and lead smelter from the 1950's to 1983 and was zoned Light Industrial from 1 March 1955, up until 1 September 1982 when it was rezoned to Restricted Light Industrial. After decommissioning of the facility, the site was cleared and rezoned for residential use (Reserved Living Zone) on 30 March 1988. Following rezoning of the land, the site was subdivided and subsequently sold for residential use.

In 1989, during the initial development of the residential properties, the Environment Protection Authority identified serious lead contamination, and the development was



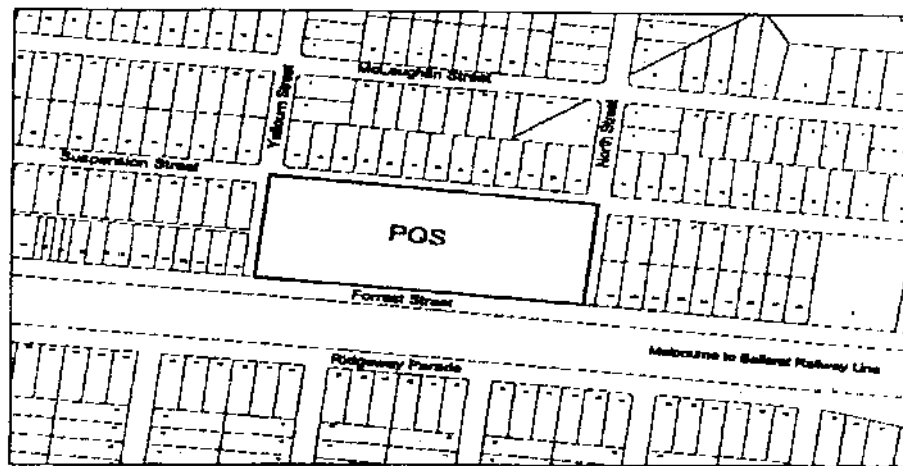
required to cease. The State Government subsequently acquired each allotment and prepared a management plan for the future use of the land as a community park.

Ministerial Direction No. 1 requires that where land is to be rezoned for a sensitive land use, that an environmental audit must be undertaken by an accredited auditor. This has been completed by Woodward Clyde in accordance with the Ministerial Direction, and the findings are contained within the report 'Ardeer Community Park Remediation Validation Report' (August 1997). The Environmental Auditor was commissioned by the Joint Management Committee with the intention of issuing a Statement or Certificate of Environmental Audit for the site, to allow its use as the Public Open Space to be known as Ardeer Community Park. The remediation works have resulted in the environmental condition of the land being well within that required for parkland use.

The proposed Amendment will effectively result in the closure of this long running issue and result in the ultimate development of the land as a community park and its reservation as Public Open Space. Under the new format Brimbank Planning Scheme the Public Open Space reservation will be translated into a Public Park and Recreation Zone.

It is considered that the proposed Amendment will result in the provision of a community park that will benefit local residents and it is unlikely to have any negative environmental, social or economic impacts.

- Linton Primary School provided a similar service for this student which proved quite successful, providing socialisation activities, co-operative games and the like. The applicant will provide the same.
- Because of physical strength of the student and some of his behaviour traits, the position would be best suited to a male, who may need at times to physically separate students.
