Water Act 1989

CHANGE OF MEMBERSHIP OF THE SOUTH GIPPSLAND REGION WATER AUTHORITY

I, PATRICK JOHN McNAMARA, Minister for Agriculture and Resources and Minister administering the **Water Act 1989**, make the following Order :

Citation

1. This Order is called the Change of Membership of the South Gippsland Region Water Authority Order 1998.

Enabling Powers

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2 of Part Six of the **Water Act 1989** and all other available powers.

Date of Effect

3. This Order takes effect immediately on its publication in the Government Gazette.

Definitions

4. In this Order :

“Act” means **Water Act 1989**.

“The Authority” means the South Gippsland Region Water Authority which was constituted by an Order dated 21 December 1994 and effective from 1 January 1995 under Division 2 of Part 6 of the **Water Act 1989** and published in the Victorian Government Gazette on 22 December 1994.

Change to the Membership

5. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect :

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Constitution Order, the membership of the Authority is six members appointed by the Minister in writing.

Prerequisites for Making this Order

6. This is an Order referred to in Section 99 (8) of the Act.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ACQUIRE

To: Harpley Nominees Pty Ltd, 10 Cecil Street, South Melbourne 3205 and all or any other interests in the land.

Roads Corporation (VicRoads) is acting as agent for the Melbourne City Link Authority pursuant to Section 38 of the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995**.

The Melbourne City Link Authority intends to acquire your interest in the land described hereunder for the construction of the Melbourne City Link:

Area: 23 square metres.

Description: being part of the land in Crown Lease Volume 1212 Folio 5136 and being part of Crown Allotment 9 Section 60 Parish of Melbourne South and shown hatched on Plan Numbered SLG/LA 5212.

The Authority thinks the land is suitable for the construction of the Melbourne City Link. The land described is deemed to have been reserved under a planning instrument for a public purpose pursuant to Section 43 of the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995** and will be required for construction purposes by 30 August 1998.

Section 8(1)(g) of the **Land Acquisition and Compensation Act 1986** requires VicRoads, on behalf of the Melbourne City Link Authority, to seek the following information:

1. The name of any other person who has, or you think may have, an interest in the land. Such a person might be a tenant or a mortgagee or a person to whom you have agreed to sell the land.
2. If you have a current building permit or a planning permit concerning the land.
3. If you have sold or let or in any other way dealt with the land or were intending to deal with the land immediately before you received this notice.
4. Any other information that you think

would be relevant to working out what compensation you should receive for the land.

Upon receipt of your advice in relation to the above matters, the Authority will negotiate with you for the value of your interest in the above described land and for all damage that may be sustained by you by reason of the execution of the said work on the said land.
