ORDER NO. 2/1998

Title

1. This Order may be cited as the Melbourne Cricket Ground (Operation of Floodlights) Order No. 2/1998.

Objectives

2. The objectives of this Order are to:-
 - (a) specify the day and time during which the floodlights affixed to the floodlights towers at Melbourne Cricket Ground may be operated; and
 - (b) specify the purposes for which the floodlights may be operated on that day; and
 - (c) make provision in relation to vehicle entry into the Yarra Park Reserve.

Authorising Provision

3. This Order is made under Section 3 of the **Melbourne Cricket Ground Act 1984**.

Floodlights may be operated on certain days at certain times and for certain purposes

4. The floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground may be operated for the purpose of playing Australian Football League matches after 5.00 p.m. on 8 May 1998.

Yarra Park Reserve - Entry of Vehicles

5. On the day on which the floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground are permitted to be used for the purposes specified in Clause 4, vehicular traffic is not permitted to enter into the Yarra Park Reserve by way of Vale Street after 5.00 p.m.
