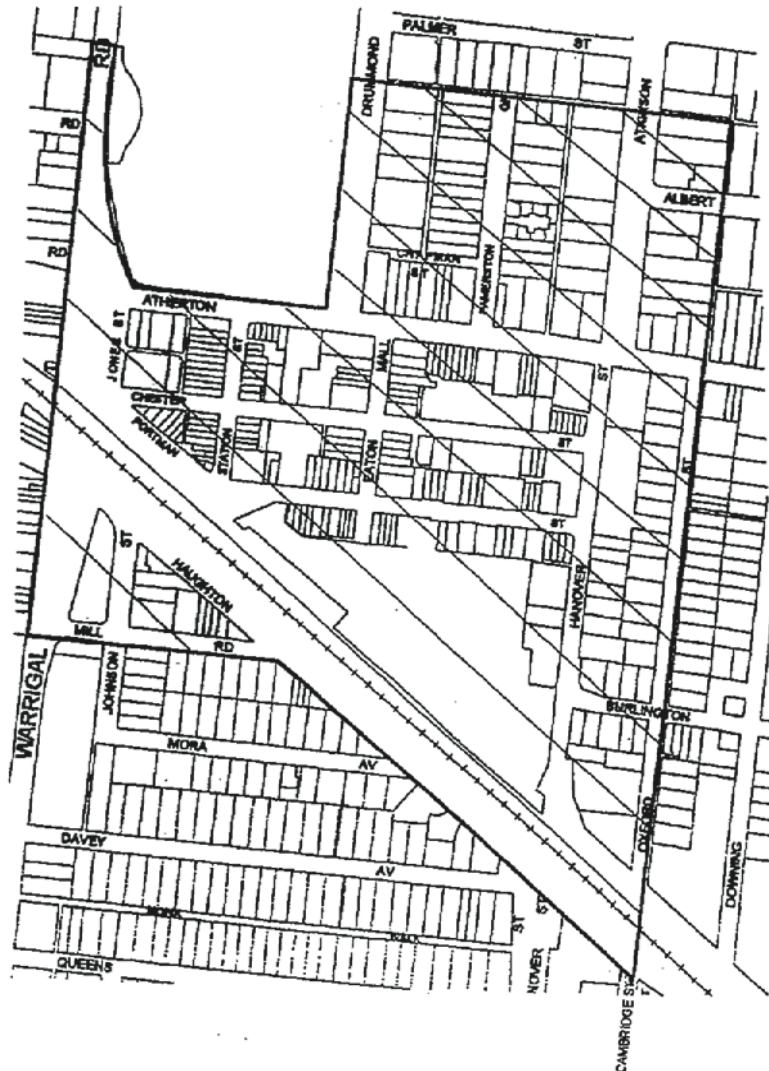

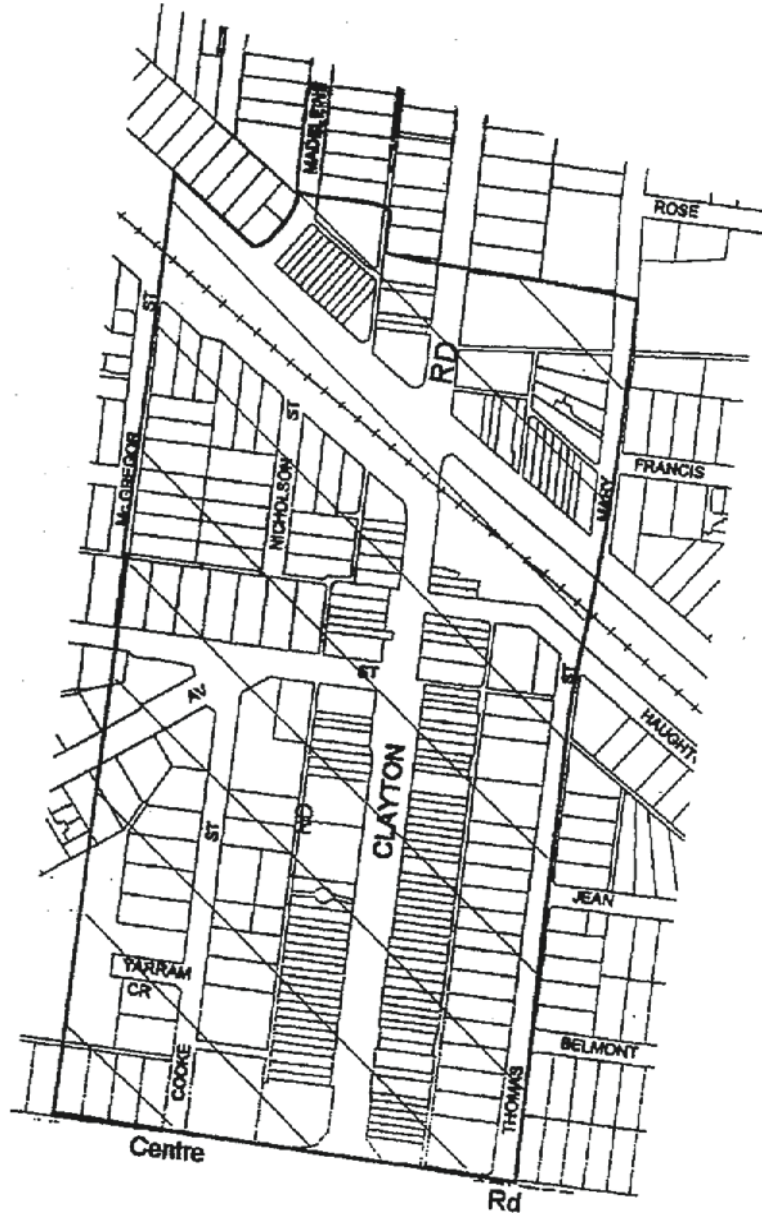

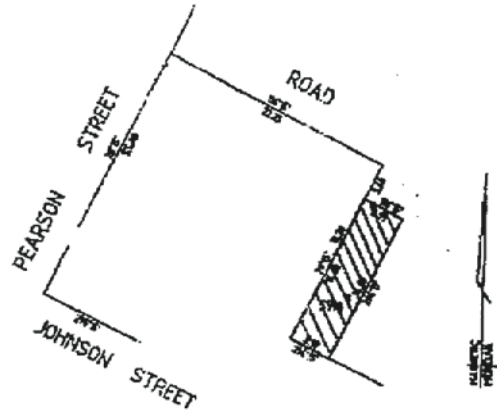

DOG CONTROL ORDER

At its meeting held on 15 April 1998, Loddon Shire Council resolved to adopt Dog Control Order No. 1 pursuant to Section 26 of the Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994.

1. Dogs must be on leashes

The owner of the dog must keep the dog on a chain, cord or leash not exceeding 1.5 m in length when in any public area in the municipality or in any reserve, or part of a reserve, not designated under this order.

2. Owners must be equipped to remove Dog Faeces

The owner of the dog must carry a bag, receptacle or other means of picking up and removing, from any public place any of the owner's dog's faeces.



Pursuant to Section 206 and Schedule 10 of the Local Government Act 1989 the

3. Owner's Obligations Designated Reserve

A dog may be exercised off a chain, cord or leash in a designated reserve if the owner:

- Carries a chain, cord or leash not exceeding 1.5 m in length sufficient to bring the dog under effective control if the dog behaves in a manner which threatens any person or animal.
- Remains in effective voice or hand management of the dog so as to be able to promptly place the dog on a chain, cord or leash not exceeding 1.5 m in length, if that becomes necessary.
- Does not allow the dog to worry or threaten any person or animal.
- Always keeps the dog in sight.
- Carries a bag, receptacle or other means of picking up, and removing from the public place, any of the dog's faeces.

If a dog is off a chain, cord or leash in a designated area it must be brought under effective control by means of a chain, cord or a leash not exceeding 1.5 m in length if the dog is or is likely to be within twenty metres of:

- (a) The arena or ground of an organised sporting or practice event.
- (b) An occupied children's play equipment area.
- (c) A principal location of an organised public meeting.
- (d) An occupied permanent barbecue or picnic area.

4. Meaning of Words

In this Order

- "Prohibited Public Area" means a Public Area that cats and dogs may not enter.
- "Owner" has the same meaning as the **Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994**; and
- "Public Area" has the same meaning as public place in the **Summary Offences Act 1966**.
- "Designated Reserve" means any reserves, or part of a reserve, declared by resolution of the Council.

5. That dogs shall at all times be prohibited in the following Public areas:-**List of Prohibited Reserves - Schedule 1**

Boort Jajowerough Park; Boort Jubilee Park; Boort Swimming Pool; Bridgewater

Sloans Park; Dingee Progress Park; Inglewood Swimming Pool; Korong Vale Borella Park; Mitiamo Swimming Pool; Pyramid Hill Lions Park; Pyramid Hill Swimming Pool; Wedderburn Jacka Park Playground Area; Wedderburn Swimming Pool.

6. The following conditions are imposed on the presence of dogs in the following public areas:**List of Designated Reserves - Schedule 2**

Boort Historic Reserve; Boort Myrnong Beach; Boort Nolans Park; Boort Park; Boort Rotary Park; Boort Sailing Club, Boort Ski Club; Boort Sunnyside Court Playground; Boort Walking Track; Bridgewater Recreation Reserve; Calivil Recreation Reserve; Dingee Recreation Reserve; Inglewood Gordon Park; Inglewood Recreation Reserve; Korong Vale Recreation Reserve; Laanecoorie River and Recreation Reserve; Mitchell Park Showgrounds & Recreation Reserve; Mitiamo Recreation Reserve; Mitiamo R. J. 2. Authorising provisions

This Order is made under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

3. Revocation

The Order Declaring a Restricted Area for the Control of Fire Blight and the Prohibitions, Restrictions and Requirements which are to operate in the Restricted Area made on 15 October 1997 is revoked.

4. Definition

In this Order-

"Fire blight" means the exotic disease fire blight caused by the bacterium *Erwinia amylovora*.

5. Restricted area for the control of fire blight

The restricted area for the control of fire blight is within a 10 kilometre radius of the William Tell Shelter (centre point 37° 49'58" South 144°58'42" East) in the Royal Botanic Gardens, Melbourne.

6. Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements

- (1) The removal from the restricted area of any of the plants described in Schedule 1 is prohibited unless the person is authorised to do so under a permit issued under section 21 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** by an inspector and complies with the conditions set out in the permit.
- (2) Owners or occupiers of places in that part of the restricted area which is

specified in Schedule 2 are required to destroy or prune or permit the destruction or pruning of all of the plants listed in Schedule 1, as directed in writing by an inspector.

- (3) Owners or occupiers of places in that part of the restricted area which is specified in Schedule 2 are prohibited from planting and propagating plants or plant products listed in Schedule 1, within that part of the restricted area.

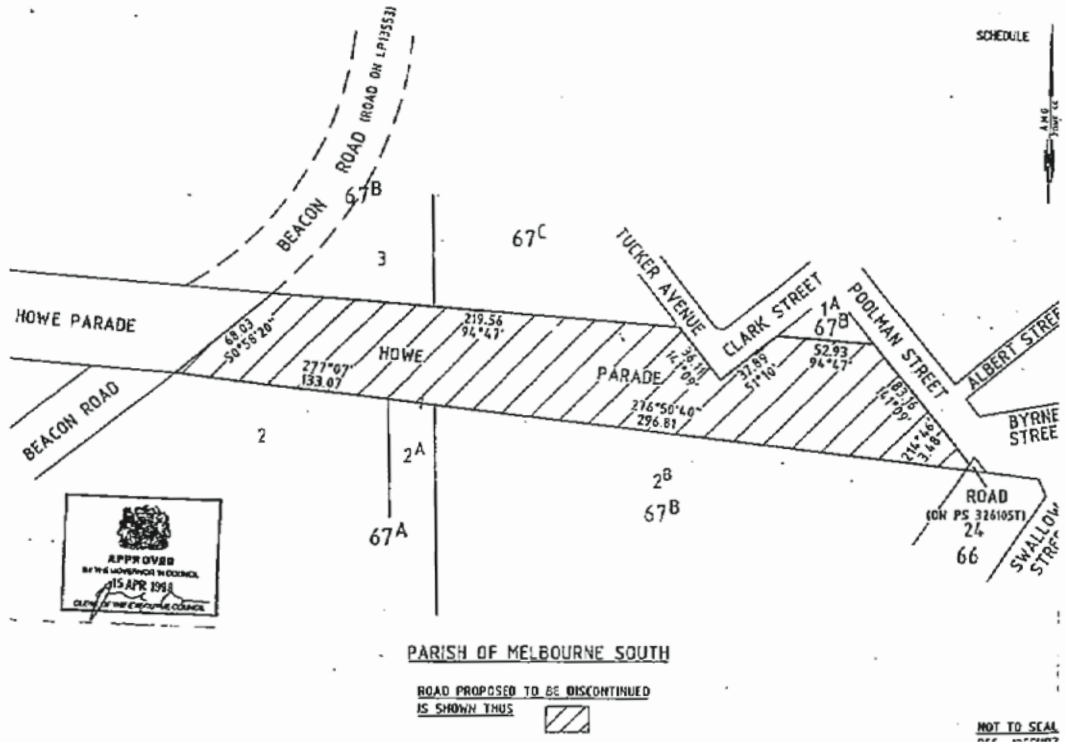

VARIATION OF ACCESS CODE UNDER
SECTION 48U

ORDER IN COUNCIL

The Lieutenant-Governor as the Governor's deputy, with the advice of the Executive Council, under section 48U of the **Gas Industry Act 1994**, hereby varies the Victorian Third Party Access Code for Natural Gas Pipeline Systems (the Code) established by an Order in Council dated 9 December 1997 and published in Victoria Government Gazette No. G49 on Thursday, 11 December 1997 in the following manner:

1. In section 2.51 of the Code for the words "This clause has been left deliberately blank" **substitute** -
"Where:
 - (a) before 11 December 1997 the Service Provider (or, where the Service Provider did not exist at that date, a person able to represent and bind the future Service Provider) submitted a proposed Access Arrangement with respect to a pipeline that became a Covered Pipeline on that date together with the applicable Access Arrangement Information (if relevant) to the person who is under this Code the Relevant Regulator for that Covered Pipeline; and
 - (b) the Relevant Regulator commenced before that date to do in substance the things it would have been required to do in relation to the proposed Access Arrangement and the applicable Access Arrangement Information had this Code been in force prior to the date of submission,
the Relevant Regulator must continue to do those things".
2. In section 2.52 of the Code:
 - (a) in paragraph (b)(i) after the words "done the things" **insert** -
"(whether before or after the date on which this Code takes effect)";
 - (b) in paragraph (b)(i) after the words "Access Arrangement Information" **insert** -
"as if";
 - (c) in paragraph (b) after the words "the Relevant Regulator has approved" **insert** -
"(whether before or after the date on which this Code takes effect)";
 - (d) in the last sentence for the words "shall be deemed to have been accepted and approved under this Code" **substitute** -
"and actions taken in relation to them shall be deemed to have been accepted and approved, and to have been done, under this Code";
3. In section 3.18(b)(ii) of the Code, for the expression "pursuant to section 2.27", **substitute** "pursuant to section 2.28".
4. In section 3.30(d) of the Code, **delete** "(iv)" (where secondly occurring) and **insert** "(v)".
5. In section 3.6 of the Code, for the expression "sections 3.23 to 3.38" **substitute** "sections 3.23 to 3.40".
6. In section 3.37, for the expression "pursuant to section 3.5(a)" **substitute** "pursuant to section 3.36(a)".

7. After section 3.38 of the Code insert -

"3.39 Where before 11 December 1997 a person conducted a tender in accordance with guidelines for the purposes of section 40 of the **Gas Industry Act 1994** in relation to a Pipeline that had not been built, the Relevant Regulator must approve the tender process for the purpose of this section 3.39 and then the proposed pipeline shall be a covered pipeline from the time of that decision. In any Access Arrangement for that covered pipeline:

- (a) for each Reference Service for which a Reference Tariff was determined by the tender process, the Reference Tariff shall be the Reference Tariff that was determined in accordance with the tender process; and
- (b) each other item required to be included in an Access Arrangement which the tender documents specified would be determined by the tender process shall be as determined by the tender process.

Nothing in this section limits the Reference Services for which the Relevant Regulator can require a Reference Tariff to be established.

Section 3.37 applies to a decision under this section 3.39 approving a tender process and section 3.38 applies to this section 3.39 as if the reference to section 3.36 in section 3.38 were a reference to this section 3.39.

3.40 The Relevant Regulator may permit the person who conducted the tender process and the successful tenderer to agree to changes to the terms of the tender which result in minor changes to the Reference Tariffs or other items determined by the tender process. The amended Reference Tariffs and other items shall be considered to be

determined in accordance with the tender process for the purposes of clause 3.39."

- 8. In sections 9.4 and 9.5 of the Code delete the words "in italics" (where twice occurring).
- 9. In section 9.9 of the Code, after the definition of "Relevant Regulator" insert -
" 'Relevant Regulatory Instrument' means an Order in Council, licence, code, rule or like instrument deriving its force under the **Gas Industry Act 1994.**"
