Milk used in the production of "Vita Plus" is market milk for the purposes of the above Act.

**DECLARATION OF AN AREA AT TOOLANGI TO BE A CONTROL AREA FOR THE
PURPOSE OF PREVENTING THE INTRODUCTION OF CERTAIN PESTS AND DISEASES**

 - (c) only for human consumption.

3. The introduction into the control area of any rubus plants is prohibited unless the rubus plants are -
 - (a) accompanied by a plant health certificate or a plant health declaration stating that the plants have been examined in a manner approved by the Secretary for the diseases listed in Part 2 of Schedule 3 and no diseases are have been found; or
 - (b) certified in accordance with the provisions of a certification scheme approved by the Minister in accordance with section 40 of the Act.
4. The introduction into the control area of any strawberry plants is prohibited unless the strawberry plants are-
 - (a) accompanied by a plant health certificate or a plant health declaration stating that the plants have been examined in a manner approved by the Secretary for the diseases listed in Part 3 of Schedule 3 and no diseases have been found; or
 - (b) certified in accordance with the provisions of a certification scheme approved by the Minister in accordance with section 40 of the Act.
5. The introduction into the control area of any container or agricultural equipment which has been used for planting, cultivation or harvesting potatoes or other root vegetables is prohibited unless the container or equipment has been cleaned free of all plant material and soil and is accompanied by a plant health certificate or a plant health declaration.

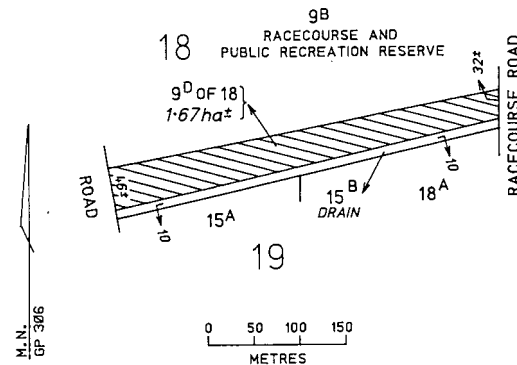

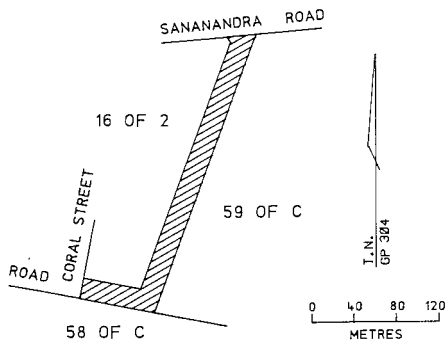

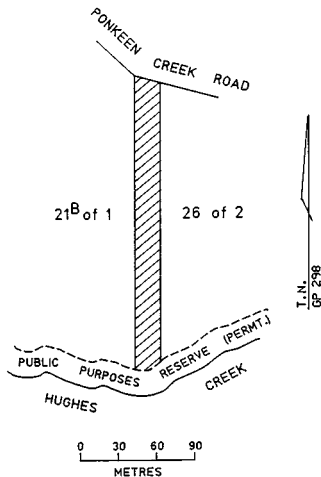
