



Gas Industry Act 1994

DIRECTION UNDER PART 6A OF THE GAS INDUSTRY ACT 1994

To further ensure the safe and sure supply of gas, I, DAVID KNIPE, Chief Executive Officer of VICTORIAN ENERGY NETWORKS CORPORATION pursuant to an instrument of delegation of 25 September 1998 from Alan R Stockdale being the Minister responsible for the **Gas Industry Act 1994** ("the Act") and in exercise of the powers under section 62G of the Act, **DIRECT**:

- (i) all consumers of tempered liquefied petroleum gas ("TLPG") in Horsham and Colac (other than hospitals, aged and infirm residential institutions) until further notice:
 - to immediately cease the use of TLPG;
 - to turn off all TLPG appliances and meters; and
 - not turn on any TLPG meter; and
- (ii) KINETIK ENERGY PTY LTD, WESTAR PTY LTD, CFA, STATE EMERGENCY SERVICES, VICTORIA POLICE and their servants, agents and persons authorised to act on their behalf, to stop the flow of TLPG to all consumers of TLPG gas in Horsham and Colac (other than hospitals, aged and infirm residential institutions) and to do any matters or things in connection with, or incidental to, stopping the flow of TLPG to all such consumers (other than hospitals, aged and infirm residential institutions) including entering any land, building or structure.

This Direction takes effect at and from 2:30 p.m. on 28 September 1998.
