Planning and Environment Act 1987 GREATER GEELONG PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Amendment

Amendments R224 & R236

The City of Greater Geelong has prepared Amendments R224 & R236 to the Greater Geelong Planning Scheme.

Amendment R224

The Amendment proposes to amend the Regional Section of the Greater Geelong Planning Scheme to rezone approximately 16.3 hectares of land at the north western corner of Forest Road South and Canterbury Road West, Lara from Rural General Farming zone to Reserved Residential zone subject to the further investigation of likely occasional sheet-water occurrences, and the determination of satisfactory floor levels.

Amendment R236

The Amendment proposes to amend the Regional Section of the Greater Geelong Planning Scheme by rezoning a 0.375 ha site on the east side of Ballan Road, between Carrs & Dorrington Roads, Anakie from Rural General Farming zone to Public Purposes (Existing) reservation No. 4 (Barwon Water).

Upon reading the material tendered in support of this application the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from Sections 13, 100 & 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to advertise and appoint a male or female worker, as appropriate in its employment service to enable the service to cater for the needs and wishes of male and female clients.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- Brotherhood of St. Laurence, Employment Services ("BSL") currently employ three females and one male worker. The male worker has a full caseload and is unable to take new clients.
- Clients are referred by Centrelink and are given the choice of a male or female worker. The occupational psychologist has in her assessments suggested a male worker for some clients. 75% of clients referred to BSL are male.
- The community support programme assists people with barriers to employment. These barriers can be drug and alcohol misuse,

long criminal records, gambling problems, domestic violence and housing issues.

• BSL wants to offer all clients a choice of male or female worker to assist them in gaining employment. BSL wishes to be able to cater for those clients who express a preference for a male or female worker to assist.

The Tribunal grants an exemption from the operation of Sections 13, 100 and 195 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 1995**, to enable the applicant to advertise and appoint a male or female worker, as appropriate in its employment service to enable the service to cater for the needs and wishes of male and female clients.

This exemption is to remain in force from the day on which notice of the exemption is published in the Government Gazette until 20 January 2002.
