**Melbourne City Link Act 1995**  
**TERMINATION OF LICENCES**  
**ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 56**

1. Purpose  
The purpose of this Instrument is to terminate all licences issued pursuant to section 56 of the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995** ("the Act").
2. Authority for Instrument  
This Instrument is made under section 56(6)(a) of the Act and in accordance with the Agreement, in particular —
  - (a) the State has received a notice in writing under clause 4.13 (d) of the Agreement (as amended by the Ninth Amending Deed) requesting the termination of all licences issued under section 56 of the Act and in existence as at 14 December 1999;
  - (b) the State has agreed to that request; and
  - (c) the Agent has, for the purposes of clause 10 of the Master Security Deed, by a Notice dated 21 December 1999, provided written consent to the termination of those licences.
3. Termination of Licences  
The Authority terminates all licences issued under section 56(1) of the Act (being all of the licences in existence as at 14 December 1999), with effect at 10.10 am on Tuesday, 21 December, 1999.
4. Definitions  
Any word, expression, reference or term used in this Instrument which is defined or given a special meaning in the Agreement, the Act or the licences, shall, unless the context otherwise requires, have the same meaning in this Instrument.

## Notes

The Order in Council under section 59 (2) of the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995** published in Government Gazette No. S181 on 14 December 1999 revoked all Project reservations in existence at that time. Section 59 (3) provides that an Order under section 59 (2) has effect immediately on the termination of the licences under section 56 as to that land. Consequently, the Project reservations of all licensed land are also revoked with effect at 10am on 21 December 1999.
