VARIATION OF PROHIBITED PERIODS

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 3 sub section (2) of the **Forests Act 1958**, I, Gary Morgan, delegated officer for the Minister for Conservation and Land Management in the State of Victoria, hereby vary the declaration of the Prohibited Period with respect to the fire protected area (other than State forest, National park and protected public land) within the municipalities nominated for the period specified in the schedules below:
