Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981

SECTIONS 12G AND 12K

Notice Regarding the Amendment, Commencement and Availability of the Poisons Code

I, Rob Knowles, Minister for Health, give notice that the Poisons Code, prepared under sections 12 and 12E of the **Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981**, will be amended by incorporating by reference amendments to the Commonwealth standard as prescribed by the Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances (Commonwealth Standard) Regulations 1995.

The Poisons Code is a document that enables certain parts of the Commonwealth standard, particularly those parts relating to the uniform scheduling, labelling and advertising of drugs and poisons, to be incorporated by reference and then applied as law in Victoria.

The Poisons Code will be amended to the extent that earlier incorporated by reference material, being the Standard for the uniform scheduling of drugs and poisons (SUSDP) No. 12 as amended by SUSDP No. 12 Amendment Nos. 1, 2 and 3 and SUSDP No. 13 Amendment No. 1, will be amended, varied, remade or superseded to the extent necessary by the incorporation by reference of SUSDP No. 13 as amended by SUSDP No. 13 Amendment Nos. 1 and 2.

The date fixed for the amending, varying, remaking or superseding material to take effect is 18 March 1999.

Melbourne City Link Act 1995 NOTICE TO PUBLIC BODIES






The land shown diagonally hatched and shaded on the following plan:




Land shown diagonally hatched on the following plan:




Land shown shaded on the following plan:
