#### ROAD TRANSPORT REFORM (DANGEROUS GOODS) REGULATIONS 1997

##### Determination of Route for the Transport of Liquefied Gases for March 1999

The Victorian WorkCover Authority (the Authority), a Competent Authority within the meaning of section 13 of the **Road Transport Reform (Dangerous Goods) Act 1995** of the Commonwealth, applying as a law of Victoria by virtue of section 5 of the **Road Transport (Dangerous Goods) Act 1995**, may, under Regulation of the 13.7 Road Transport Reform (Dangerous Goods) Regulations 1997 of the Commonwealth, applying as a law of Victoria by virtue of section 6 of the **Road Transport (Dangerous Goods) Act 1995**, determine that particular dangerous goods may only be transported by road on particular routes and at particular times.

Accordingly, under Regulation 13.7, the Authority determines that liquefied gases which are to be transported by road between the Elgas Limited terminal at Greens Road, Dandenong, and the intersection of Dudley Street and Footscray Road, Melbourne, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. during the period commencing on 4 March 1999 and ending on 7 March 1999, both dates inclusive, may only be transported along the following routes:-

- A From the Elgas Limited terminal at Greens Road, Dandenong, to the intersection of Dudley Street and Footscray Road, Melbourne, the route must be:-

West along Greens Road and Hutton Road to Springvale Road, then north along Springvale Road to Lower Dandenong Road, then west along Lower Dandenong Road to the Nepean Highway, then northwest along the Nepean Highway to South Road, then west along South Road to Esplanade, then north along Esplanade to St Kilda Street, then north along St Kilda Street to Ormond Esplanade, then northwest along Ormond Esplanade to Marine Parade, then north along Marine Parade to Jacka Boulevard,

then north along Jacka Boulevard to Beaconsfield Parade, then west along Beaconsfield Parade to Pickles Street, then north along Pickles Street to Ingles Street, then north along Ingles Street to Normanby Road then east along Normanby Road to Montague Street then north along Montague Street to Charles Grimes Bridge Road, then north along Charles Grimes Bridge Road to Footscray Road, then north along Footscray Road to Dudley Street.

- B From the intersection of Dudley Street and Footscray Road, Melbourne, to Elgas Limited terminal at Greens Road, Dandenong, the route must be:-

The reverse of Route A above.
