PROPOSED HOUSE CONTRACTS GUARANTEE REGULATIONS 1999

The proposed Regulations remake the House Contracts Guarantee Regulations 1988 to reflect the reduced role of the Housing Guarantee Fund Limited (the Fund), because of the reforms to the domestic house construction and renovation industry introduced by the **Domestic Building Contracts Act 1995**, which came into operation on 1 May 1996.

The effect of the introduction of these reforms was to confine the role of the Fund under the **House Contracts Guarantee Act 1987** (the Act), to the handling of claims under guarantees still to run out under the Act. The reduced role of the Fund was recognised in 1995 when the Act was amended to facilitate the handling of claims and to give effect to the final winding up of the Fund.

The overall objective of the proposed Regulations is to enable the Fund to carry out its remaining functions under the Act until it is wound up, and to protect the interests of persons who entered into building contracts prior to 1 May 1996.

The proposed Regulations prescribe three forms required to enable the continued administration of the Act, and prescribe a fee for the issue of a certificate under sections 25(3) and (4) of the Act.

A Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared for the proposed Regulations. It sets out the proposed Regulations and their objectives, and justifies the amount of the proposed prescribed fee by examining and explaining the process of issuing certificates used by the Fund. The RIS explains how the issue of a certificate is costed with reference to the tasks required for their issue.
