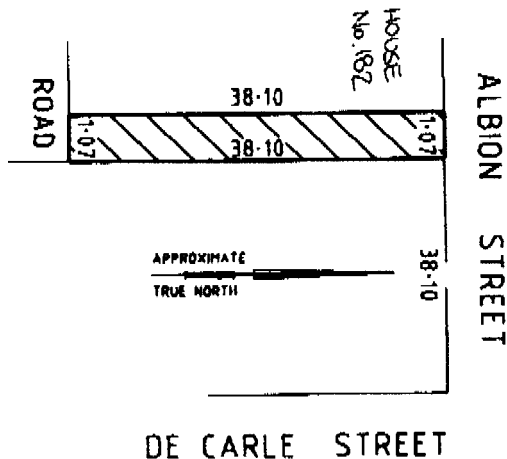

Tertiary Education Act 1993

GUIDELINES ISSUED BY THE MINISTER FOR TERTIARY EDUCATION AND TRAINING (PURSUANT TO SECTION 10 (4) OF THE TERTIARY EDUCATION ACT 1993) TO BE USED FOR CONSIDERING APPLICATIONS BY INSTITUTIONS FOR APPROVAL TO OPERATE AS A UNIVERSITY

1. INTRODUCTION

Guidelines have been developed to assist institutions applying under Section 10 of the **Tertiary Education Act 1993** for approval to operate as a university. The guidelines relate both to the provisions of the Act and to government policies and priorities and are published pursuant to Section 10 (4) of the Act.

1.1 *Institutions Established in Other Countries -*

Where an institution established as a university in another jurisdiction seeks approval to operate in Victoria, consideration will be given to the standing of the institution in relation to relevant accreditation processes in the other country, and in addition, to the academic standards and levels of resources to be provided within Victoria. Where such an institution seeks to work in cooperation with a Victorian institution through franchising or agency arrangements, the operating entity within Victoria must meet the criteria prescribed in Section 10 (3) of the Act and these statutory guidelines.

1.2 *Professional Bodies -*

Where an institution proposes to offer programs leading to accreditation by professional bodies, the views of the relevant bodies on all or part of the application may be sought.

1.3 *New Institutions -*

(a) It is recognised that where a new institution is proposed it will not be possible to demonstrate achievement of relevant performance standards at the time of initial review. However, the level of resources available, the experience of those involved and plans for development must be such that there is a high probability of the criteria and performance indicators being met within a specified time frame.

(b) In such cases the development will be closely monitored and progress towards achievement assessed on a regular basis. The Minister may establish conditions when granting approval, may make approval conditional upon receiving progress reports on the new institution which, in the Minister's opinion, are satisfactory, may require sponsorship by an existing university and may establish other conditions or procedures.

1.4 *Criteria and Indicators of Capacity and Performance -*

(a) In considering applications, the Minister, Department and review panels will have regard to statements about the nature of universities and criteria and indicators of performance such as those published by the Australian Vice-Chancellors Committee (AVCC) in 1989 and 1996, to comparative indicators of university performance published by the Commonwealth Department of Education, Employment and Youth Affairs, and to policy statements on universities by the Victorian Government.

(b) While size criteria as specified by the AVCC have been excluded by the policies of the Victorian Government, the size of an institution may have relevance to levels of financial and academic resources, capacity to undertake research, and educational viability.

2. CRITERIA AND PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

2.1 Criteria

(a) The standard of any courses of study to be offered by the University

Undergraduate and postgraduate awards must be equivalent in standard to those offered at the same level by a recognised university (A "Recognised University" for the purposes of the **Tertiary Education Act 1993** is an institution that is established or recognised as a University under an Act of an Australian Parliament)

Forms of evidence might include:

- confirmation that credit has been or will be granted by a recognised university for studies undertaken in the proposed university;
- commitment of the institution and staff to the advancement and dissemination of knowledge through teaching and research;
- evidence that teaching and research are prime functions of the proposed university and qualifications and research performance of staff are comparable to those of recognised universities;
- evidence that courses will meet appropriate professional, national and international standards, and produce graduates who have good employment acceptability;
- existence of and capacity to maintain quality assurance processes which will allow objective and accountable review of academic activities.

(b) *The academic, and financial and staffing resources of the University which would be available in Victoria.*

The proposed university's resources and infrastructure must be at a level sufficient to sustain a broad range of teaching, scholarship and research.

Forms of evidence might include:

- Staffing ratios
- library resources
- equipment for research and teaching
- levels of support staff
- staff professional development arrangements
- existence of a strategic plan and mission to further enhance the proposed university's infrastructure and teaching and research ambitions
- procedures which result in rational determination of resource allocations

(c) *The views or recommendations of any relevant industrial or professional body about the courses of study to be offered by the University*

Forms of evidence might include:

- documentary evidence that the courses of the proposed university have met or will meet entry criteria prescribed by relevant professional, industrial or registering bodies;
- opinions of professional bodies about the standard of the courses of study and the resources provided.

2.2 Indicators of Actual or Expected Performance Relating to the Criteria

The following indicators of performance will be taken as representing minimum standards:-

- at least 25 percent of all academic staff (both full and part-time) have or will have a relevant doctorate or equivalent professional qualification and research experience;
- an average of at least 0.5 refereed publications per annum per equivalent full-time staff member;
- an average of at least one competitive external research grant per annum per 20 equivalent full-time staff at the level of lecturer and above;
- non-academic staff associated with the conduct of the proposed university of an appropriate nature and number and in comparable proportions to those of public universities offering similar programs.

 - (b) Before she applies to remove the suspension, she must have attended at least 2 consultations with a psychiatrist pursuant to paragraph 1 of this determination.
 - (c) With her application to remove the suspension, she must produce a letter from the psychiatrist which:-
 - (i) includes a report on the consultations and counselling to that date, which is acceptable to the Board; and

- (ii) satisfies that in the psychiatrist's opinion, she is fit to recommence practice as a division 2 nurse.

6. An individual quota unit for the Abalone Fishery in the eastern and western abalone zones in the quota year is 1000 kg of unshucked abalone.
7. Each Abalone Fishery Access Licence holder is to be allowed 20 individual quota units for the quota year.
8. An Abalone Fishery Access Licence holder must hold at all times during the quota year at least 10 individual quota units.
9. An Abalone Fishery Access Licence holder must not hold at any time during the quota year more than 30 individual quota units.
10. If an Abalone Fishery Access Licence holder holds more than one Abalone Fishery Access Licence, the Licence holder -
 - (a) must hold at all times during the quota year at least 10 individual quota units in relation to each Licence; and
 - (b) must not hold at any time during the quota year more than 30 individual quota units in relation to each Licence.

11. For the purposes of clauses 8, 9 and 10, in determining how many individual quota units are held at a particular time during the quota year in respect of a Licence, any individual quota units that have been taken under the Licence during the quota year before that particular time are to be counted.
