In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- Parks Victoria proposes to construct works to develop and maintain the weir and sewerage ponds area at Tidal River, Wilsons Promontory. The area is part of the Wilsons Promontory National Park. That Park is covered by Heritage Protection legislation of Victoria and the Commonwealth and is also the subject of a Native Title Claim.
- Discussions have been held with the local Aboriginal community which indicate that there is a need to engage a consultant nominated by that community who will be able to give appropriate advice to Parks Victoria if sites of Aboriginal cultural

significance are discovered during construction or if construction raises other signs of cultural issues.

- A recommendation to this effect is included in the report titled "Flora, Fauna & Archaeological Guidelines, Grey & Potable Water Proposed Re-development, Tidal River Wilsons Promontory National Park", by Biosis Research Pty Ltd, dated December 1998.
- This application is made to enable Parks Victoria to comply with this recommendation, to ensure that it obtains the most appropriate advice on these issues and to enable it to carry out his construction work in a way that takes into account relevant aspects of Aboriginal culture, to ensure that it appropriately protects any site of Aboriginal cultural significance which it discovers during the work, and to meet the concerns experienced by the local Aboriginal community.
- The person to be employed will be nominated by the local Aboriginal community through a process of disseminating by the Central Gippsland Aboriginal Health and Housing Co-operative and the Gippsland Region Cultural Heritage Unit within the community, information about this employment opportunity, encouraging people to express interest in that opportunity and then consulting widely within that community.

The Tribunal grants an exemption from the operation of Sections 13, 100 and 195 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 1995**, to enable the applicant to employ a person nominated by the Aboriginal Community to fill a term position with Parks Victoria.

PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS ACT 1986

CODE OF PRACTICE FOR THE WELFARE OF HORSES COMPETING AT BUSH RACE MEETINGS

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Code is to provide the minimum standards for the welfare of horses competing at bush race meetings in Victoria.

The Code does not apply to any race meeting held under the Rules of Racing of the Victoria Racing Club or the Rules of Harness Racing of the Harness Racing Board.

2. AUTHORITY

The Code is made under section 7(1) of the **Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1986** and complements the provisions of the Act and the Code of Practice for the Welfare of Horses made by the Governor in Council on 15 December 1988 and published in the Government Gazette No. 18 on 18 December 1988 and the Code of Practice on the Welfare of Farm Animals during Transportation made by the Governor in Council on 20 August 1985 and published in the Government Gazette No. 91 on 28 August 1985.

Section 24 of the Act provides that the following groups of personnel may take action to investigate offences against Part 2 of the Act relating to the protection of animals -

- members of the police force
- authorized persons from the RSPCA, the Public Service and from individual municipalities.

Compliance with this Code will be relevant in deciding whether to proceed with any prosecution for offences under Part 2 of the Act.

3. DEFINITIONS

“Bush race meeting” means a meeting on a day or on consecutive days at which a mountain race or a flat race is conducted, but does not include a race meeting held under the Rules of Racing of the Victoria Racing Club or the Rules of Harness Racing of the Harness Racing Board;

“Flat race” means a horse race at a bush race meeting conducted at high speed on a course over relatively flat terrain which is free of obstacles or hazards;

“Meeting” means a bush race meeting;

“Mountain race” means a horse race at a bush race meeting conducted at high speed on a course over variable terrain which may include obstacles and hazards such as trees and water;

“Organisers” means the club or organisation which is responsible for the conduct of a bush race meeting;

“Race” means a heat, trial or final of a flat race or a mountain race;

“Veterinary practitioner” means a veterinary practitioner registered under the Veterinary Practice Act 1997.

4. APPLICATION

- 4.1 This Code applies to bush race meetings held in Victoria.
- 4.2 This Code does not apply to any race meeting held under the Rules of Racing of the Victoria Racing Club or the Rules of Harness Racing of the Harness Racing Board.
- 4.3 Unless otherwise stated, the organisers are responsible for ensuring compliance with this Code.

5. VETERINARY PRACTITIONERS

- 5.1 A veterinary practitioner must be in attendance at a bush race meeting at all times. At large meetings it may be necessary to engage more than one veterinary practitioner, taking into account the nature of the course, the length of the race and the anticipated number and experience of competitors. (Where more than one veterinary practitioner is in attendance a decision is to be made on who will complete the required veterinary report and who will investigate serious incidents.)
- 5.2 There must be a pre-race veterinary inspection of the horses to determine their fitness to start before each race.
- 5.3 The veterinary inspection must be carried out in accordance with the “Guidelines for Veterinary Inspection of Horses Competing at Bush Race Meetings”.
- 5.4 The veterinary practitioner in attendance at the meeting has the power to order the withdrawal of lame, unfit, fatigued or injured horses at any time before or during the meeting.
- 5.5 Within 7 days of each meeting the veterinary practitioner or nominated veterinary practitioner (when more than one is in attendance) must complete the attached veterinary report and forward a copy to the Bureau of Animal Welfare, Department of Natural Resources and Environment, P O Box 41, East Melbourne, Vic 3002.

6. COMPETING HORSES

- 6.1 Horses under 4 years of age must not be permitted to compete in mountain races and horses under 3 years of age must not be permitted to compete in flat races.
- 6.2 Organisers must take effective measures to ensure that the same horse is presented for the pre-race veterinary inspection and for the relevant race.
- 6.3 Lamé, unfit, injured or otherwise unsuitable horses must not be permitted to start in a race.
- 6.4 Any horse that is withdrawn or eliminated from a race on veterinary grounds must not be permitted to start in another race at the same meeting without passing a full veterinary inspection.
- 6.5 Organisers must take effective measures to ensure that horses are presented drug-free at meetings.

7. COURSE DESIGN

- 7.1 The design of the course for the meeting may test the skill of the horse and rider but must not place unreasonable demands on the horses.
- 7.2 The course must be inspected by the organisers at least 30 days prior to the meeting to allow any necessary alterations to the course - site and design.
- 7.3 Within 24 hours of the meeting, the organisers must inspect the course and modify the course if any part of it is considered dangerous to the horses.

- 7.4 The organisers have the final responsibility for the course site and design. Organisers must take into account the advice of the attending veterinary practitioner in the event that adverse conditions such as heat and humidity or heavy going place unreasonable demands on competing horses.
- 7.5 Organisers must ensure that all riders walk or ride over the course on which they will compete prior to the race.

8. RIDERS

- 8.1 Any rider who appears to the organisers to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol must not be permitted to take part in a race.
- 8.2 Injured riders must have a medical examination before riding in further races during a meeting.
- 8.3 Organisers must take effective measures to prevent riders riding dangerously, disregarding horse welfare during meetings, riding under the influence of drugs or alcohol or misrepresenting the identity of a horse.
- 8.4 All riders must wear appropriate riding boots with heels.

9. GEAR

- 9.1 The organisers must ensure that a gear inspection of all competing horses and riders takes place before each race.
- 9.2 All horses must be shod with correctly fitting shoes. Toe grabs are not permitted.
- 9.3 All bandages must be stitched. Velcro fastened boots must be taped.
- 9.4 Organisers must prohibit a rider from using a bit which is deemed to be detrimental to the welfare of a horse.
- 9.5 Only spurs of a "dummy" kind (ie. without rowels) may be used. All spurs must be taped.
- 9.6 Riders in mountain races must not be permitted to carry hand held whips. Organisers must take effective measures to prevent riders in flat races from using hand-held whips of a type or in a manner which is detrimental to the welfare of a horse.
- 9.7 Standing martingales are not to be used. Running martingales, if used, should be properly fitted and should not unduly restrict head movement.

10. INJURIES AND DEATHS

- 10.1 The organisers must ensure that equipment is available to enable transport of injured horses from the course to a place of treatment and to allow prompt humane destruction of injured horses if necessary.
- 10.2 Organisers must, within 24 hours of a race meeting conduct a thorough investigation including a report from the attending veterinary practitioner as to the cause of injury or death, and the action taken to prevent a repetition of the incident. The report of such an investigation is to accompany the veterinary report, required under Clause 5.5 of this Code and be sent to the Bureau of Animal Welfare, P O Box 41, Department of Natural Resources and Environment, East Melbourne, Vic 3002.

11. RACE SUPERVISION

Organisers must ensure that all races are supervised by an adequate number of sufficiently experienced officials with authority to render assistance to injured riders or horses, supervise riding behaviour, catch riderless horses and withdraw injured or fatigued horses.

12. AVAILABILITY OF INCORPORATED MATERIAL

Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995
DECLARATION OF A CONTROL AREA AT
CARDROSS FOR THE PURPOSE OF
PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF
QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY

The Lieutenant-Governor as the Governor's deputy with the advice of the Executive Council under section 9 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** -

- (i) declares the area described in Schedule 1 to be a control area for the purpose of preventing the spread of Queensland fruit fly (*Bactrocera tryoni*);
- (ii) prohibits the removal from the control area into any part of Victoria of any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland fruit fly in Schedule 5 of the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996, unless the fruit or vegetable is accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate or Plant Health Declaration and/or has been treated, processed or transported under security in a manner approved by the Secretary;
- (iii) requires owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2, which is within the control area, to give access to such land at all times to an authorised officer with or without assistants for the purpose of inspection and/or placing on such land any lures or traps and/or for applying on such land any spray material or bait and for performing any other actions which in the opinion of the authorised officer are necessary for the eradication and/or prevention of spread of the pest; and
- (iv) requires owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2, which is within the control area, on instructions from an authorised officer, to strip fruit from trees, collect and dispose of waste fruit, or treat fruit and vegetables listed in Schedule 5 of the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996 in a manner approved by the Secretary.

Schedule 1

The area of land around the outbreak centre at Cardross (Longitude: 142° 8.32' Latitude: 34° 15.88') bounded by a line commencing from the junction of Little Cowra Road and the Victorian side of the Murray River, then along

The Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal has considered an application pursuant to Section 83 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 1995** by Genevieve Berenyi, Principal, on behalf of the Austin Hospital School. The application for exemption is to enable the applicant to employ a male teacher for the school in a 6 month contract from July to December 1999.

Upon reading the material tendered in support of this application the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from Sections 13, 100 & 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to employ a male teacher for the school in a 6 month contract from July to December 1999.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- The school provides education to patients of the Austin and Repatriation Medical Centre.
- Students have physical health problems or serious emotional, behavioural or psychiatric problems.
- The vacancy exists in the Statewide Child Inpatient Unit, where 2.5 out of 3.5 teaching positions are already filled by female teachers.
- A male teacher is important to provide balance in the lives of these children who are in a residential facility who are predominantly staffed by women.
- A male teacher is also important to assist boys aged between 5 and 13 years with toileting, change rooms at swimming and other community needs.
- The school council believes it is important to employ a male teacher where 90% of its students are male.
- The applicant also wishes to employ a male teacher to be able to promote a gender balance among its staff.

The Tribunal grants an exemption from the operation of Sections 13, 100 and 195 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 1995**, to enable the applicant to employ a male teacher for the

school in a 6 month contract from July to December 1999.

This exemption is to remain in force from the day on which notice of the exemption is published in the Government Gazette until 31 December 1999.
