**Rules of the Game—Big Wheel**

By this notice, the Victorian Casino and Gaming Authority **amends** the Rules in respect of the game “Big Wheel” (approved by notice published in the Victoria Government Gazette on 24 April 1997 (S44) and amended by notice published 18 June 1998 (S58)) as set out in the Schedule.

### 1. Amendments to rule 2

(1) After rule 2.1.2, insert—

- 2.1.3 Option 3 as shown in diagram “E”.
  - 2.1.3.1 8 sections exhibiting one particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.2 8 sections exhibiting a second particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.3 8 sections exhibiting a third particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.4 4 sections exhibiting a fourth particular symbol; or number.

  - 2.1.3.6 4 sections exhibiting a sixth particular symbol; or number.

  - 2.1.3.9 2 sections exhibiting a ninth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.10 2 sections exhibiting a tenth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.11 2 sections exhibiting an eleventh particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.12 2 sections exhibiting a twelfth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.13 1 section exhibiting a thirteenth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.14 1 section exhibiting a fourteenth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.15 1 section exhibiting a fifteenth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.3.16 1 section exhibiting a sixteenth particular symbol; or number.
- 2.1.4 Option 4 as shown in diagram “G”.
  - 2.1.4.1 8 sections exhibiting one particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.4.2 8 sections exhibiting a second particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.4.3 8 sections exhibiting a third particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.4.4 8 sections exhibiting a fourth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.4.5 4 sections exhibiting a fifth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.4.6 4 sections exhibiting a sixth particular symbol; or number.
  - 2.1.4.7 4 sections exhibiting a seventh particular symbol; or number.

- 2.1.4.8 4 sections exhibiting an eighth particular symbol; or number.
- 2.1.4.9 2 sections exhibiting a ninth particular symbol; or number.
- 2.1.4.10 1 section exhibiting a tenth particular symbol; or number.
- 2.1.4.11 1 section exhibiting an eleventh particular symbol; or number.’.

(2) For rule 2.2, **substitute**—

‘2.2 The game shall be played on a table with a layout cloth marked in a manner similar to those displayed in the diagrams.’.

(3) After rule 2.2.2, **insert**—

- ‘2.2.3 The layout used for Option 3 as described in 2.1.3 will be marked in a manner similar to that shown in diagram “F” with:
  - 2.2.3.1 the sixteen symbols or numbers and the odds applicable to each symbol or number imprinted thereon; and
  - 2.2.3.2 the name and/or logo of the casino imprinted thereon.
- 2.2.4 The layout used for Option 4 as described in 2.1.4 will be marked in a manner similar to that shown in diagram “H” with:
  - 2.2.4.1 the eleven symbols or numbers and the odds applicable to each symbol or number imprinted thereon; and
  - 2.2.4.2 the name and/or logo of the casino imprinted thereon.’.

**2. Amendments to rule 6**(1) For rule 6.2, **substitute**—

‘6.2 Winning Wagers for Option 2 will be paid as follows.’.

(2) After rule 6.2, **insert**—

- ‘6.3 Winning Wagers for Option 3 will be paid as follows:
  - 6.3.1 Winning wagers on spaces marked “A” shall be paid at odds of 5 to 1.
  - 6.3.2 Winning wagers on spaces marked “B” shall be paid at odds of 5 to 1.
  - 6.3.3 Winning wagers on spaces marked “C” shall be paid at odds of 5 to 1.
  - 6.3.4 Winning wagers on spaces marked “D” shall be paid at odds of 11 to 1.
  - 6.3.5 Winning wagers on spaces marked “E” shall be paid at odds of 11 to 1.
  - 6.3.6 Winning wagers on spaces marked “F” shall be paid at odds of 11 to 1.
  - 6.3.7 Winning wagers on spaces marked “G” shall be paid at odds of 23 to 1.
  - 6.3.8 Winning wagers on spaces marked “H” shall be paid at odds of 23 to 1.
  - 6.3.9 Winning wagers on spaces marked “I” shall be paid at odds of 23 to 1.
  - 6.3.10 Winning wagers on spaces marked “J” shall be paid at odds of 23 to 1.
  - 6.3.11 Winning wagers on spaces marked “K” shall be paid at odds of 23 to 1.
  - 6.3.12 Winning wagers on spaces marked “L” shall be paid at odds of 23 to 1.
  - 6.3.13 Winning wagers on spaces marked “M” shall be paid at odds of 47 to 1.
  - 6.3.14 Winning wagers on spaces marked “N” shall be paid at odds of 47 to 1.
  - 6.3.15 Winning wagers on spaces marked “O” shall be paid at odds of 47 to 1.
  - 6.3.16 Winning wagers on spaces marked “P” shall be paid at odds of 47 to 1.
- 6.4 Winning Wagers for Option 4 will be paid as follows:
  - 6.4.1 Winning wagers on spaces marked “A” shall be paid at odds of 5 to 1.
  - 6.4.2 Winning wagers on spaces marked “B” shall be paid at odds of 5 to 1.
  - 6.4.3 Winning wagers on spaces marked “C” shall be paid at odds of 5 to 1.



DIAGRAM F

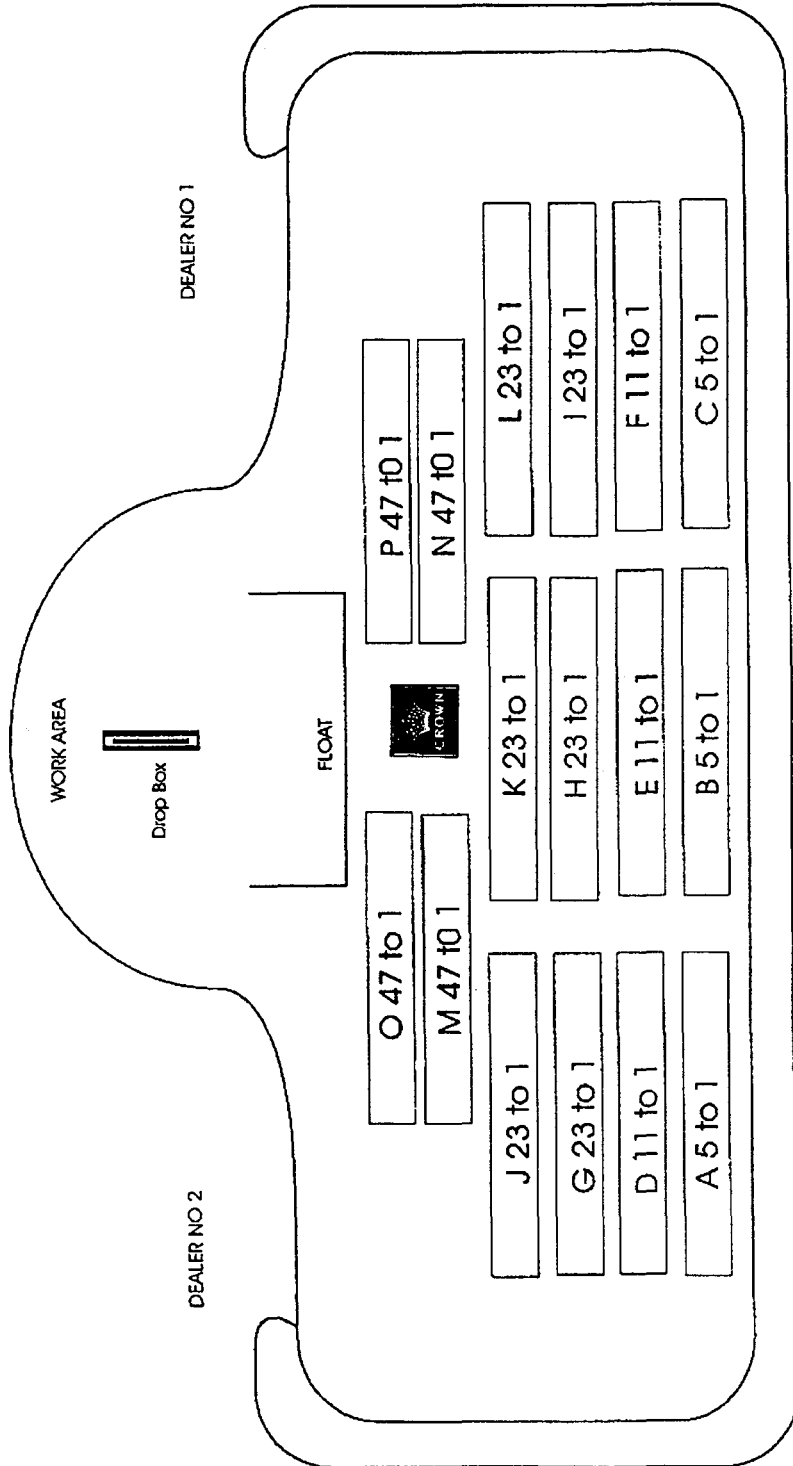
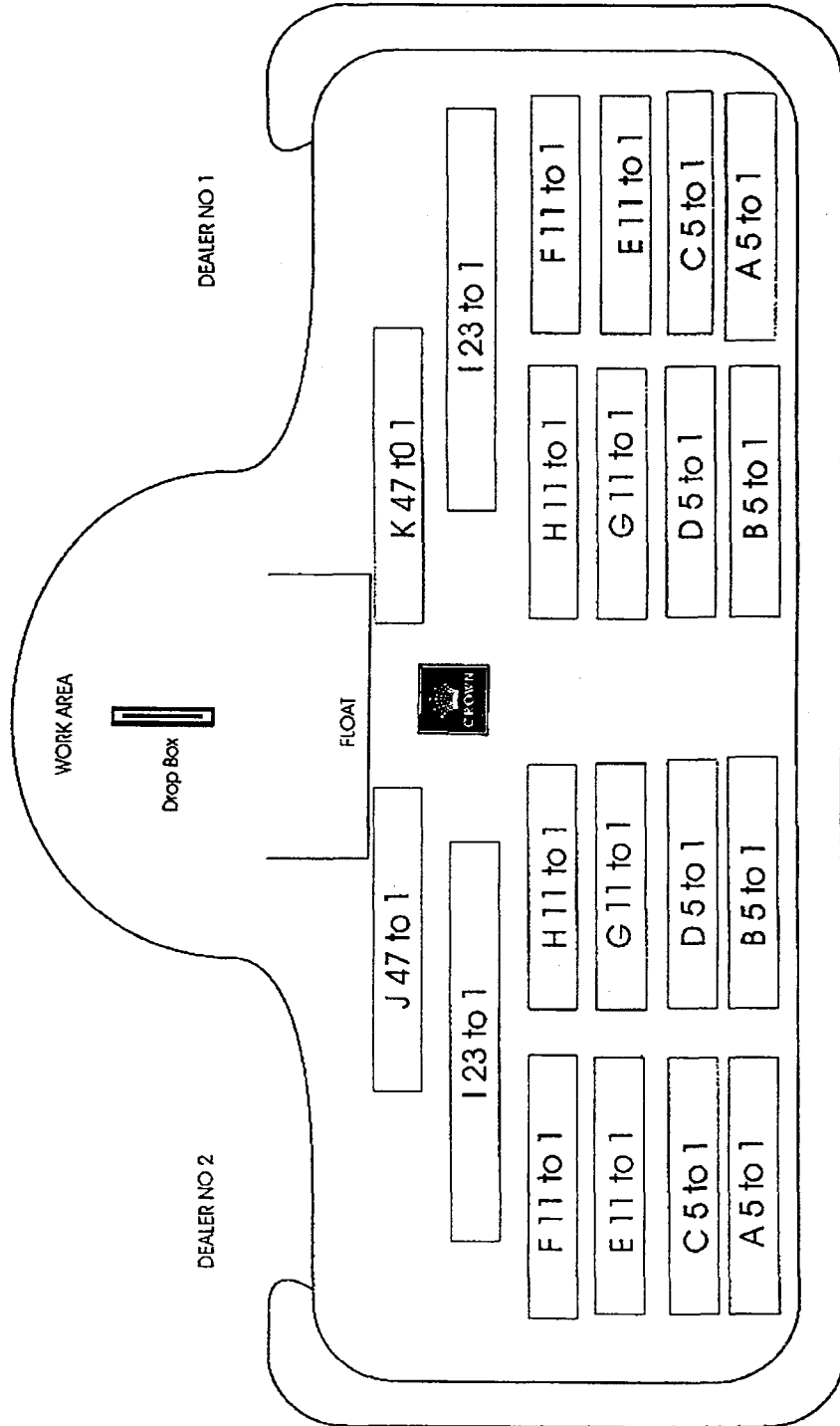

**CASINO RULES NOTICE NO. 17 OF 1999**  
Rules of the Game—Two-Up

By this notice, the Victorian Casino and Gaming Authority **amends** the Rules in respect of the game “Two-Up” (approved by notice published in the Victoria Government Gazette on 24 April 1997 (S44) and amended by notice published 18 June 1998 (S58)) as set out in the Schedule.

This notice operates with effect from 4.00am on 13 September 1999.

Schedule

**1. Amendments to rule 7**

(1) For rule 7.3.2, **substitute**—

‘7.3.2 either or both of the coins hit the spinner, gaming staff or anything, except each other or the sides of the ring below the layout surface or the ceiling directly above the ring.’

(2) For rule 7.6, **substitute**—

‘7.6 The boxer may direct the spinner to return the coins and further exclude that spinner from re-entering the ring prior to the close of play where the boxer considers that the spinner.’

**2. Amendments to rule 8**

(1) For rule 8.2, **substitute**—

‘8.2 The spinner’s wager shall win and his/her wager shall remain in place until: -.’

(2) For rule 8.3, **substitute** —

‘8.3 The spinner’s wager shall lose and his/her wager shall remain in place until: -.’

**CASINO RULES NOTICE NO. 18 OF 1999**  
Rules of the Game—Blackjack

By this notice, the Victorian Casino and Gaming Authority **amends** the Rules in respect of the game “Blackjack” (approved by notice published in the Victoria Government Gazette on 24 April 1997 (S44) and amended by a notice published on 30 April 1998 (G17) and Casino Rules Notices No. 1 of 1999 (S39—18 March 1999) and No. 13 of 1999 (S121—13 August 1999)) as set out in the Schedule.

This notice operates with effect from 4.00am on 13 September 1999.

## Schedule

**1. Amendment to rule 5**For rule 5.6, **substitute**—

‘5.6 Where more than one player wagers on a playing area the decisions with regard to the cards dealt to that area shall be called by the player whose wager is nearest the dealer.’.

**2. Amendment to rule 14**After rule 14.2.2, **insert**—

‘14.2.3 A wager on a player’s hand with a count value in excess of 21.’.

**3. Amendments to rule 22**After rule 22.5.1, **insert**—

‘22.5.1.1 Where the dealer’s first card is an Ace, a player who has achieved Pontoon shall not be eligible to place an insurance wager.’.

For rule 22.5.3, **substitute**—

‘22.5.3 After all player Pontoons and hand totals of 21 have been settled the dealer will offer the players the option to surrender where the dealer’s first card is an Ace, King, Queen or Jack.’.

For rule 22.6.2, TABLE 2: SUPER BONUS, **substitute**—**‘TABLE 2: SUPER BONUS**

<b>Super Bonus</b>	
7,7,7 same suit and dealer first card any 7	\$1,000 if bet \$2 to \$24 \$5,000 if bet \$25 or greater
All other wagers (winning or losing) on the round of play in which there is a Super Bonus winner shall be eligible to receive a Bonus payment of \$50.	

For rule 22.7.4, **substitute**—

‘22.7.4 All winning double hands shall be paid at odds of 1 to 1 and shall not be eligible for payout odds and Super Bonus odds as set out in Tables 1 and 2.

‘22.7.4.1 Where a player elects not to double in line with the player controlling the box, that player’s winning hand is paid at odds of 1 to 1, and is not eligible to be paid at other payout odds as described in Tables 1 and 2.’.

After rule 22.7.5, **insert**—

‘22.7.5.1 Each player wagering on a betting area may make the decision to play or forfeit their wager irrespective of the decision made by the player controlling the box.’.
