 - Wye River: The beach area between the foreshore toilet block and the rock outcrop at the eastern end of the beach.
 - Separation Creek: The entire beach area. Described as the sand area between the rocky outcrops at both ends of the beach.
- Colac Otway Shire Council declares the shopping precincts of Colac and Apollo Bay as areas where dogs must be on a leash and attended by their owner at all times. Effective 1 November 2000. These areas are described below:

NO CATS ZONE – “THE WATERWAYS”
(Amendment to Local Law No. 6 –
Birds, Animals, Poultry, Rodents and Bees)

11(4) “Clause 11(3) will not apply to landowners who had purchased land in stage 1 of “The Waterways” and who owned cats at the time of purchase, provided that:

- a) cats are confined indoors or in a totally enclosed pen or yard in the premises;
- b) when the cat is outside the owner’s premises, it is confined within an enclosed cage or a closed motor vehicle”.

11(5) “The immunity provided under clause 11(4) shall lapse in relation to a given property upon the sale of that property”.

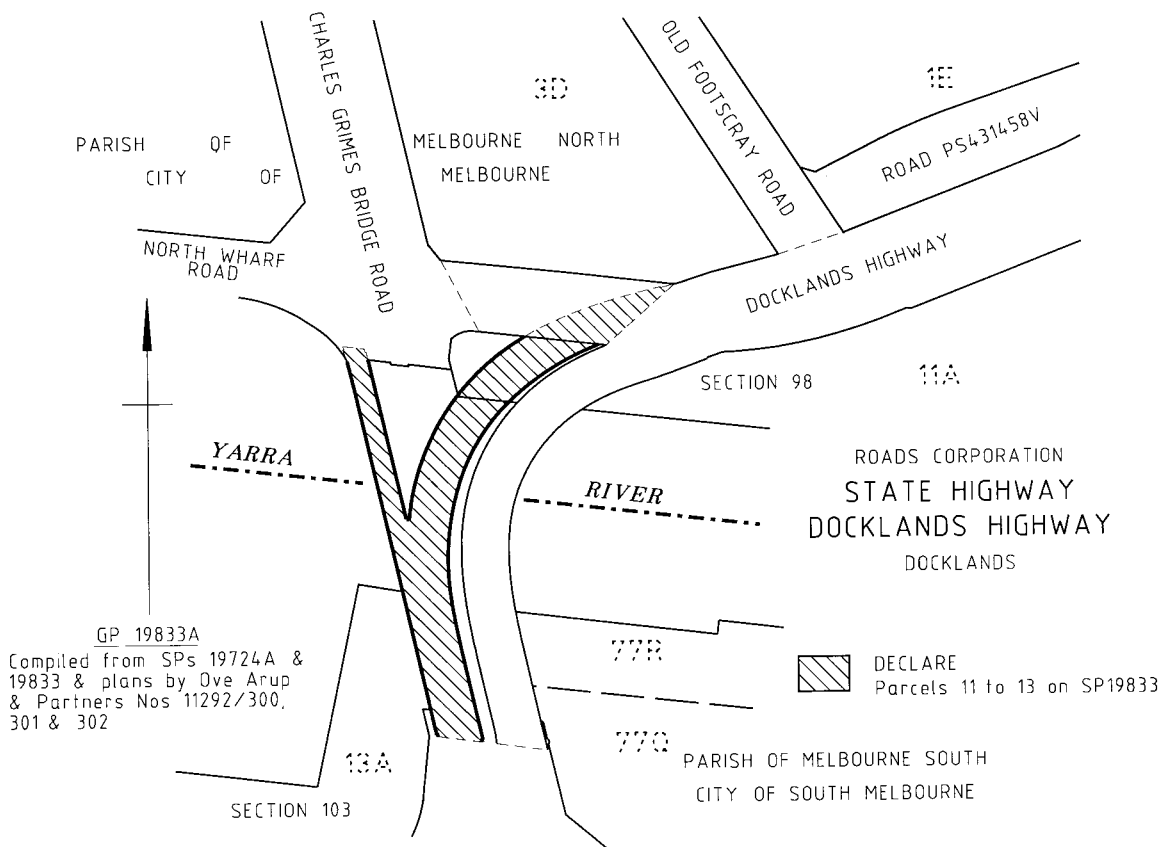

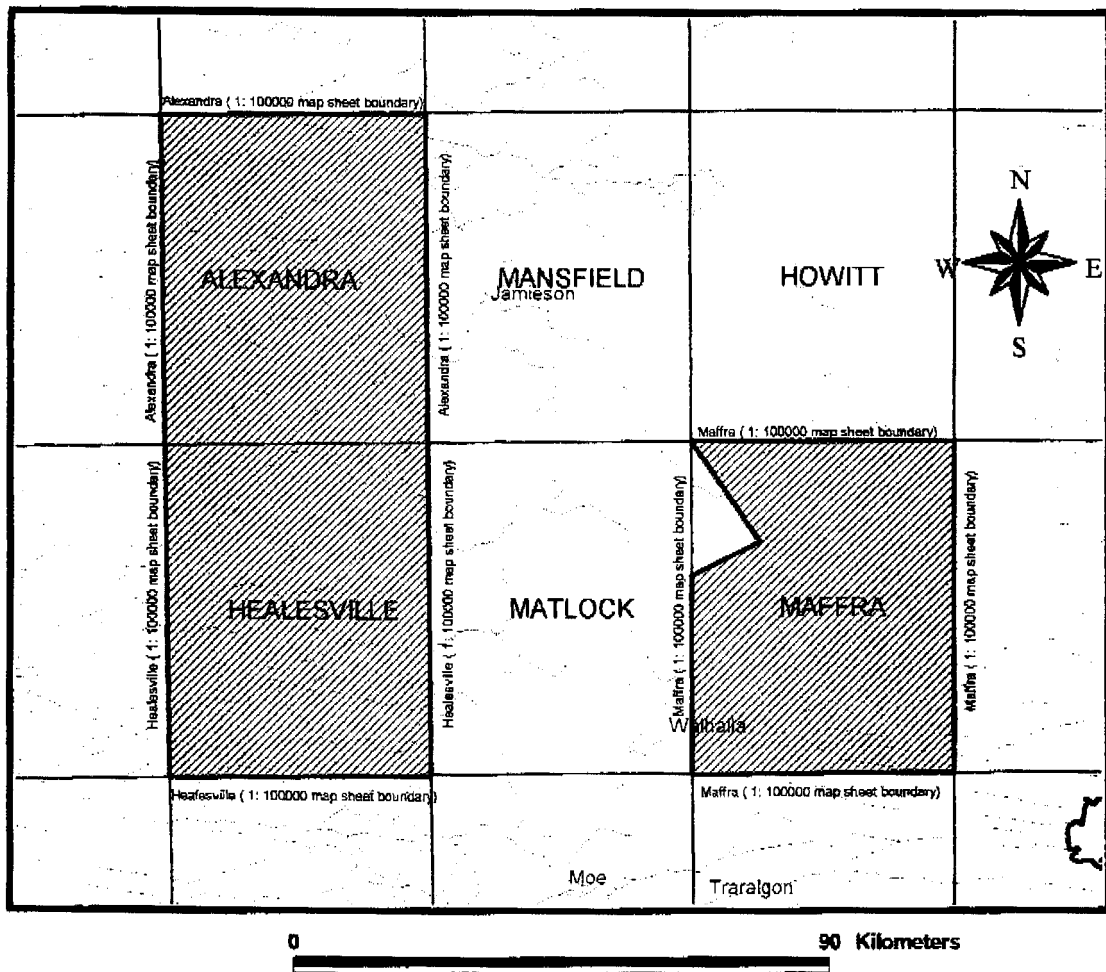

- (b) declares that a veterinary practitioner or a pharmacist acting in accordance with the written directions of a veterinary practitioner must not sell an unregistered veterinary chemical product unless—
 - (i) the unregistered veterinary chemical product is for the treatment of an animal other than a stock animal and the unregistered veterinary chemical product is accompanied by the following written information—
 - (A) the business name and address of the veterinary practitioner or pharmacist selling the product; and
 - (B) the specific use and amount of the product to be administered; and
 - (C) the re-treatment interval (if any); and
 - (D) the route of administration; or
 - (ii) the unregistered veterinary chemical product is for the treatment of a stock animal and the quantity of the unregistered veterinary chemical product is sufficient to treat only a single stock animal; or
 - (iii) the unregistered veterinary chemical product is for the treatment of an animal for export and contains a constituent listed in the Schedule and is to be used solely for the purpose specified in the Schedule and the unregistered veterinary chemical product is accompanied by the following written information—
 - (A) the business name and address of the veterinary practitioner or pharmacist selling the product; and
 - (B) the specific use and amount of the product to be administered; and
 - (C) the re-treatment interval (if any); and
 - (D) the route of administration; and
 - (E) the withholding period applicable to the specified use of the product; or
 - (iv) the sale is in accordance with a permit issued under section 25(2)(b) of the Act.
