Melbourne City Link Act 1995

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 71(1)

Under section 71(1)(a) of the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995** ("the Act"), Transurban City Link Limited ABN 65 070 810 678 (the relevant corporation in relation to the Link road) specifies the following toll zones on the Link road:

| Toll Zone | Area on the Link road |

| 4 | That part of the Link road being the Domain Tunnel and that part of the Link road leading into that Tunnel between the eastern portal of that Tunnel and Punt Road, other than that part of the Link road – |
| | (a) being the eastbound carriageways of the Link road; |
| | (b) between Punt Road and the exit to Boulton Parade; and |
| | (c) comprising Boulton Parade. |
| 7 | That part of the Link road between Burnley Street and Punt Road and including that part of the Link road – |
| | (a) between Punt Road and the exit to Boulton Parade, other than the eastbound carriageways; and |
| | (b) comprising Boulton Parade, |
| | other than: |
| | (i) the eastbound carriageways between Burnley Street and Punt Road; and |
| | (ii) that part of the Link road being the Burnley Tunnel and that part of the Link road leading out of that Tunnel between the eastern portal of that Tunnel and Burnley Street. |
| 9 | That part of the Link road between Glenferrie Road and Burnley Street, other than the eastbound carriageways. |
| 11 | That part of the Link road between Punt Road and Swan Street Intersection, other than – |
| | (a) the eastbound carriageways; |
| | (b) that part of the Link road being the Burnley Tunnel; |
| | (c) that part of the Link road: |
| | (1) between Punt Road and the exit to Boulton Parade; and(2) comprising Boulton Parade; and |
| | (d) that part of the Link road being the Domain Tunnel and that part of the Link road leading into that Tunnel between the eastern portal of that Tunnel and Punt Road. |

For the avoidance of doubt, a reference in this Notice to the specification of a toll zone by reference to Burnley Street refers to that point on the Link road where Burnley Street would cross the Link road if Burnley Street continued in a straight southerly direction from its southernmost extremity. For the avoidance of doubt, a reference in this Notice to "eastbound" means in a general easterly direction from the eastern end of the West Gate Freeway towards Glenferrie Road.

The Schedule as attached shows details of the location of toll zones 4, 7, 9 and 11 and is for illustrative purposes only; the Schedule is not to be used for the purpose of construing this Notice.

For the avoidance of doubt, this Notice also:

- (i) revokes or repeals; or, in the alternative
- (ii) amends -

the NOTICE UNDER SECTION 71(1) dated 15 September 2000 and published in the Victoria Government Gazette (Special) No. S130 (pages 3 to 5), dated 15 September 2000 ("the Last Notice").

This Notice takes effect on 21 December 2000, and for the avoidance of doubt, the Last Notice ceases to have effect when this Notice takes effect, and the revocation, repeal, amendment or ceasing to have effect of the Last Notice shall not:

- (a) revive anything not in force or existing at the time at which the revocation, repeal, amendment or ceasing to have effect becomes operative;
- (b) affect the previous operation of the Last Notice or anything duly done or suffered under the Last Notice;
- affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under the Last Notice;
- (d) affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed relating (directly or indirectly) to or in respect of the Last Notice; or
- (e) affect any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment as is mentioned in paragraphs (c) and (d) –

and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced, and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed, as if the Last Notice had not been revoked or repealed or amended or had not expired, lapsed or otherwise ceased to have effect.

For the purposes of this Notice, the following definitions apply:

Boulton Parade includes the off-ramp connecting the rest of the Link road to Boulton Parade;

Burnley Tunnel means the eastbound tunnel between Sturt Street and Burnley Street;

Domain Tunnel means the westbound tunnel between Punt Road and Sturt Street; and


Swan Street Intersection means the intersection between Swan Street and Batman Avenue.
