



## Electricity Industry Act 1993

### DIRECTION

Pursuant to section 47C of the **Electricity Industry Act 1993** ("the Act") I, Stephen Phillip Bracks, being the Minister responsible for the Act, hereby direct, with effect from 6 pm 7 February 2000:

- (a) Yallourn Energy Pty Ltd (ACN 065 325 224) to admit the persons who are subject to the directions specified in paragraph (b) below to the Yallourn Power Station located at Eastern Road Yallourn or other land or buildings so as to allow them to carry out those directions and to maintain and operate all services necessary to ensure the generation, supply and direction of electricity from that power station; and
- (b) all persons who were employed at the Yallourn Power Station located at Eastern Road Yallourn as at 9 January 2000, performing duties relating to the generation, supply or distribution of electricity from that power station and who have ceased to perform such duties, to perform those duties and to carry out any work required to ensure the generation, supply or distribution of electricity at that power station.

This direction operates until 21 February 2000.

**DIRECTION**

Pursuant to section 47C of the **Electricity Industry Act 1993** ("the Act"), I, Stephen Phillip Bracks, being the Minister responsible for that Act, hereby direct, authorise and empower:

1. the following persons:
  - a) CitiPower Pty Ltd (ACN 064 651 056)
  - b) Eastern Energy Ltd (ACN 064 651 118)
  - c) Powercor Australia Limited (ACN 064 651 109)
  - d) AGL Electricity (ACN 064 651 083)
  - e) United Energy Ltd (ACN 064 651 029)
  - f) Office of the Chief Electrical Inspector; and
  - g) the persons named in the attachment to this Directionto:
  - i) assist and encourage compliance with the Directions and Direction Variations issued under Part 3A of the Act;
  - ii) enter any land, building or structure used for or in connection with the provision of electricity; and
  - iii) withdraw the supply of electricity from any consumer the person reasonably believes is in breach of any direction made under section 47C(2)(a);
2. The persons specified in sub-paragraphs a) to e) of paragraph 1 of this direction and the persons specified in the attachment to this direction to perform the functions and exercise the powers provided by paragraph 1 in compliance with the coordination provided by the Office of the Chief Electrical Inspector; and
3. The Office of the Chief Electrical Inspector to coordinate the actions of the persons specified in paragraph 1 above.
