SPECIAL

ROAD SAFETY (VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 1999

Notice Concerning Car Carrier Routes

Clause 42 of Schedule 2 to the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1999 provides that a vehicle –

- (a) built to carry other vehicles on more than one deck; and
- (b) that is over 4.3 metres high; and
- (c) that is longer than 19.0 metres-

may only be used on a highway in an area, or on a route, specified by the Roads Corporation by notice published in the Government Gazette.

In accordance with that provision, I, Geoff Kloot, delegate of the Roads Corporation, specify that -

- (1) a vehicle built to carry other vehicles on more than one deck and having a maximum height of 4.6 metres may travel on all roads if it is empty or is carrying substantially complete vehicles;
- (2) a prime mover and semi-trailer combination or a truck and trailer combination built to carry other vehicles on more than one deck and having a maximum of 21.4 metres in length, may travel on all roads if—
 - (a) the combination is constructed to a maximum length of 19.0 metres, in accordance with regulation 411; and
 - (b) a vehicle being carried does not project in front of the motor vehicle by more than 1.2 metres, in accordance with regulation 415; and
 - (c) the maximum distance, measured at right angles, between the rear overhang line of the trailer and the rear of the rearmost vehicle on that trailer is 4.9 metres, in accordance with regulation 412; and.
 - (d) it is carrying substantially complete vehicles or is empty.

This Notice expires on 31 December 2004.

Nothing in this Notice authorises the driving of a vehicle in a manner or in a condition or place that is otherwise prohibited by the Regulations.
