## Wildlife Act 1975

### WILDLIFE (CONTROL OF HUNTING) NOTICE NO. 2/2000

I, Sherryl Garbutt, Minister for Environment and Conservation, make the following Notice:

**1. Title**

This Notice may be cited as the Wildlife (Control of Hunting) Notice No. 2/2000.

**2. Objectives**

The objectives of this Notice are:-

- (a) to prohibit absolutely the taking, destroying or hunting in Victoria of certain taxa of duck during specified periods; and
- (b) to set bag limits for the 2000 open season for duck.

**3. Authorising provision**

This Notice is made under section 86 of the **Wildlife Act 1975**.

**4. Commencement**

This Notice takes effect on 18 March 2000.

**5. Hunting of duck prohibited**

The taking, destroying or hunting of any taxa of duck listed in the Schedule to this Notice is prohibited in Victoria during the periods from the beginning of the first Saturday of the 2000 duck season (18 March) until 7.10 a.m. (Daylight Saving Time) east of the line of longitude at 146° 30' east, 7.20 a.m. (Daylight Saving Time) between the line of longitude at 146° 30' east and the line of longitude at 142° 30' east and 7.30 a.m. (Daylight Saving Time) west of the line of longitude at 142° 30' east, on that day.

**6. Bag limits for duck**

The bag limit for any day during the 2000 open season for the taxa of duck listed in the Schedule to this Notice is five (5) game duck including no more than one Australasian (Blue Winged) Shoveler.

**7. Penalty**

Any person who contravenes this Notice is guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty not exceeding 25 penalty units.
