Melbourne City Link Act 1995

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 71(1)

Under section 71(1)(b) of the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995** ("the Act"), Transurban City Link Limited ACN 070 810 678 (the relevant corporation in relation to the Link road) hereby fixes tolls which are payable in respect of the use of vehicles (as set out herein) on toll zones.

For the purposes of this Notice, the following definitions apply:

Bus is a Motor Vehicle having more than 12 seating positions (including that of the driver);

Car is a Motor Vehicle, other than:

- (a) a Motor Cycle;
- (b) a Light Commercial Vehicle;
- (c) a Heavy Commercial Vehicle; or
- (d) a Taxi;

even if such a Motor Vehicle is towing a trailer or caravan;

Heavy Commercial Vehicle or HCV is a Motor Vehicle, other than a Taxi, which is:

- (a) a rigid Truck with three or more axles;
- (b) an articulated Truck;
- (c) a Bus; or
- (d) a two axle rigid Truck having a gross vehicle mass which exceeds 4.5 tonnes;

Light Commercial Vehicle or LCV is a Motor Vehicle, other than a Taxi, which is a two axle rigid Truck having a gross vehicle mass which exceeds 1.5 tonnes, but does not exceed 4.5 tonnes;

Motor Cycle is a two wheeled Motor Vehicle (and includes such a Motor Vehicle even if it has a trailer, fore car or side car attached) other than a Taxi;

Motor Vehicle is a vehicle which is used or intended to be used on a highway or in a public place and which has its own motive power (other than human or animal power) but does not include:

- (a) a vehicle intended to be used on a railway or tramway; or
- (b) a motorised wheel chair capable of a speed of not more than 10 kilometres per hour which is used solely for the conveyance of an injured or disabled person;

Taxi is, at any particular time, a Motor Vehicle in relation to which a commercial passenger vehicle licence (issued under the **Transport Act 1983**) then subsists, being a licence allowing for the operation of the Motor Vehicle as a Taxi-Cab (within the meaning of the **Transport Act 1983**);

the Agreement has the same meaning as in the Act;

the Integration and Facilitation Agreement has the same meaning as in the Act;

Trip is the passage of a Car, LCV, HCV or a Taxi on one or more toll zones uninterrupted by exit and subsequent re-entry;

Truck is a Motor Vehicle other than a Bus which has a cab-chassis construction and a gross vehicle mass which exceeds 1.5 tonnes; and

vehicle has the same meaning as in the Act.

Under section 71(1)(b) of the Act and in accordance with the Agreement, the tolls listed in Table One are fixed and payable in respect of the use of vehicles on toll zones, where those vehicles are a Car, a LCV or a HCV:

| 3. That part of the Link road between Footscray Road and the West Gate Freeway | \$1.27 | \$2.03 | \$2.41 |

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Table One, under section 71(1)(b) of the Act and in accordance with the Agreement, the maximum tolls payable in respect of the use of a vehicle on a toll zone where that vehicle is a Car, a LCV or a HCV for a Trip are as listed in Table Two:

| Where the passage of the vehicle on the last toll zone comprising the Trip before exiting the Link road occurs between 6am and 8pm on the same day | \$3.81 | \$5.08 | \$5.08 |
| Where the passage of the vehicle on the last toll zone comprising the Trip before exiting the Link road occurs between 8pm on the one day and 6am on the next succeeding day | \$3.81 | \$3.81 | \$3.81 |

Under section 71(1)(b) of the Act, and in accordance with the Agreement, the tolls listed in Table Three are payable in respect of the use of vehicles on toll zones where those vehicles are Taxis:

For the avoidance of doubt, this Notice does not set Charge Tolls for the purposes of clause 3 of Schedule 3 (the Toll Calculation Schedule) of the Agreement, or clause 3 of Schedule 4 (the Toll Calculation Schedule) of the Integration and Facilitation Agreement.

For the avoidance of doubt, this Notice also:

- (i) revokes or repeals; or, in the alternative
- (ii) amends -

the **Notice under Section 71(1)** dated 31 December 1999 and published in the Victoria Government Gazette (Special) No. S 195, (pages 1 to 3), dated Friday 31 December 1999 ("the First Notice").

This Notice takes effect on 1 April 2000, and for the avoidance of doubt, the First Notice ceases to have effect on 1 April 2000, and the revocation, repeal, amendment or ceasing to have effect of the First Notice shall not:

- (a) revive anything not in force or existing at the time at which the revocation, repeal, amendment or ceasing to have effect becomes operative;
- (b) affect the previous operation of the First Notice or anything duly done or suffered under the First Notice;
- (c) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under the First Notice;
- (d) affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed relating (directly or indirectly) to or in respect of the First Notice; or
- (e) affect any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment as is mentioned in paragraphs (c) and (d) -

and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced, and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed, as if the First Notice had not been revoked or repealed or amended or had not expired, lapsed or otherwise ceased to have effect.

Wildlife (Game) Regulations 1990

**NOTIFICATION OF LOCATIONS, OPENING TIMES AND REQUIREMENTS AT
CHECKING STATIONS FOR HOG DEER**

Under regulation 40(2) of the Wildlife (Game) Regulations 1990 (the Regulations), the Secretary to the Department of Natural Resources and Environment gives notice that-

- 1. Pursuant to regulation 40(1) of the Regulations the Secretary has nominated the places specified in the Schedule below as checking stations for the purpose of recording biological, physical and other information about Hog Deer taken by hunters during the open season; and
- 2. The checking stations are located at the addresses specified in the Schedule and are open at the times specified in the Schedule; and
- 3. Pursuant to regulation 40(3)(b) of the Regulations the Secretary requires that upon taking a Hog deer carcass to a checking station hunters must provide the jawbone from each Hog Deer carcass for the purpose of examination for any disease or disorder.
