Supreme Court (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations County Court (Court Fees) (Amendment) Order Magistrates' Court (Fees, Costs & Charges) (Amendment) Regulations

A Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) was published in relation to each of the proposed Regulations assessing options available to make provision for the necessary funding support to ensure that the operations of the Supreme Court Library may be continued without diminution of services to its users.

It concluded that incorporating a modest levy on the initiation of cases in the Courts was the most equitable solution, the amount of the levy being \$10 in the Supreme Court, \$5 in the County Court and \$2.50 for cases over \$10,000 in the Magistrates' Court and for applications for Probate where the value of the estate exceeds \$1.000.

After considering the submissions received in respect of the proposed Regulations, I have determined that the regulations should be made to establish these levies.

It must be noted that the base fees for initiation of cases in the Courts to which the levy is to be added have been increased by virtue of the annual CPI revision of fees undertaken since the release of regulatory impact statement, and the total fees, inclusive of the levy, will vary slightly from those mentioned in the RIS.

I now give notice of my intention to proceed with the making of each of the proposed regulations.



## Subordinate Legislation Act 1994 VICTORIAN WORKCOVER AUTHORITY

Occupational Health and Safety (Lead) Regulations 2000

Notice is given in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994**, that a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has

been prepared in relation to the proposed Occupational Health and Safety (Lead) Regulations 2000. Notice is also given of the issuing for public comment under section 8(2) of the Occupational Health and Safety Act 1985 of the proposed Code of Practice for Lead. The proposed Code will provide practical guidance to people on how to meet their obligations under the proposed Regulations.

The objective of the proposed Regulations is to protect people against risks to their health associated with the use of lead in workplaces.

The proposed Regulations, together with the Code of Practice will give effect to the *National Standard for the Control of Inorganic Lead at Work*. This national standard has been endorsed by the National Occupational Health and Safety Commission.

The proposed Regulations will require employers to provide information, instruction and training to employees, obtain material safety data sheets for lead-containing hazardous substances used in the workplace and make them available to employees, ensure that the containers in which lead compounds are supplied are properly labelled, undertake risk assessments, provide control measures, and arrange for medical examinations and biological monitoring of the employees in lead risk jobs. Where an employee's blood lead level exceeds a prescribed amount, the employee must be removed from that job.

The costs and benefits of the proposed Regulations are considered in the RIS. The base case used in the analysis shows a positive net present value of \$7.8 million over ten years. While all models demonstrate that the benefits exceed the costs some costs may be understated and some benefits have been unable to be quantified. However, WorkCover considers that the nature of the problem is such that, when taking into account the social benefits associated with the proposed Regulations, it is reasonable to conclude the proposed Regulations best accomplish the policy objective, which is to protect people against the risks associated with the use of lead in workplaces.

In respect to alternatives to the proposed Regulations, a non-regulatory option is not considered a viable option. However a range of regulatory alternatives were considered during the development of the Regulations, including whether lead should be regulated solely by the existing Occupational Health and Safety (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 1999 or through stand alone Regulations. However, after taking into account the sources of lead exposure, the controls for lead proposed in the National Lead Standard, the structure of the Hazardous Substances Regulations and stakeholder views, WorkCover considers that the use of lead in workplaces needs to be regulated by stand-alone Regulations. Alternatives involving a narrowing of the scope or the range of regulatory duties were not considered viable because they may lead to an unacceptable level of risk for employees (and their families) who work in lead processes.

## Fisheries Act 1995

QUOTA ORDER FOR SCALLOP (OCEAN) FISHERY UNDER SECTION 64 OF THE FISHERIES ACT 1995

The Governor in Council, acting under section 64(1) of the **Fisheries Act 1995** and on the recommendation of the Minister for Energy and Resources, makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order applies for the period starting on 1 May 2000 and ending on 31 May 2000 ("the quota period").
- 2. The Total Allowable Catch ("TAC") for the Scallop (Ocean) Fishery for the quota period is 282,000 kilograms shell weight.
- 3. An individual quota unit for the Scallop (Ocean) Fishery in the quota period is 1 kilogram shell weight
- 4. Each Scallop (Ocean) Fishery Access Licence holder is to be allocated 3000 individual quota units for the quota period.

- 5. Individual quota units may only be transferred to a licence holder of a Scallop (Ocean) Fishery Access Licence.
- 6. The holder of a Scallop (Ocean) Fishery Access Licence operating under the Fisheries Act 1995 may, during the period commencing 1 May 2000 and ending 31 May 2000, take scallops by the use of a dredge from Victorian waters east of longitude 146° east.

This Order commences on 1 May 2000.

#### Parliamentary Committees Act 1968

REFERRAL OF MATTER TO THE FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, pursuant to section 4F of the Parliamentary Committees Act 1968, refers the following terms of reference to the Family and Community Development Committee of Parliament for inquiry, consideration and report to the Parliament on marketplace discrimination against women consumers and its effects on the economic wellbeing of women. In particular, the Committee is requested to:

- identify and examine the incidence and impact of price discrimination (where the price of a good or service is determined by the gender of the purchaser, not the quality of the good or service) on women consumers in the purchase of goods and services;
- identify and examine the incidence and impact of discrimination based on stereotyping of women consumers as lacking technical knowledge, lacking financial independence and unable to make 'big purchase decisions' in the purchase of goods and services and enquiries and complaints related thereto;
- consider whether existing anti-discrimination legislation (both Victorian and Commonwealth) is adequate to address

marketplace discrimination against women; and

4. consider whether intervention is necessary to reduce the incidence of discrimination against women consumers and, if so, what form that intervention should take and whether it would be best undertaken by government agencies, industry bodies or a combination of the two. In particular consider non-legislative options such as the development of codes of conduct, accreditation schemes, education and training programs and the development of information products.

Without limiting the Committee to examining only specified industries, the Committee should, in addressing the terms of reference, ensure that it considers the following industries: dry cleaning; motor vehicle repair; clothing; domestic building; and banking amd credit, including access to credit by small business women.

The Committee is required to report to the Parliament by 31 March 2001.
