PROPOSED CEMETERIES REGULATIONS 2000

Notice is given as required by section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** of the proposed making of the Cemeteries Regulations 2000.

The objectives of the regulations, proposed to be made under the **Cemeteries Act 1958**, are -

- (a) to provide for the protection of the public health and the maintenance of public decency in a public cemetery; and
- (b) to make provision for the construction and use of mausoleums; and
- (c) to limit commercial activities within a public cemetery; and
- (d) to prescribe a fee for a licence to remove a body or the remains of a body interred in a cemetery, burial ground or place of burial.

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared in accordance with the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994**.

The statement examines the costs and benefits of the proposed regulations and possible alternatives. The results of the statement are that the proposed regulations are the most efficient method of achieving the objectives.

Written submissions are invited from any interested industry or community group and from the public in relation to any matter relevant to the proposed regulations and will be received up to 28 days from the date of publication of this notice.
