## **Melbourne Cricket Ground Act 1984**

### MELBOURNE CRICKET GROUND (OPERATION OF FLOODLIGHTS) ORDER NO. 2/2000

I, Sherryl Garbutt, Minister for Environment and Conservation, make the following Order:

#### **1. Title**

This Order may be cited as the Melbourne Cricket Ground (Operation of Floodlights) Order No. 2/2000.

#### **2. Objectives**

The objectives of this Order are to –

(a) specify the days and times during which the floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground may be issued; and

(b) specify the purposes for which the floodlights may be used on those days; and

(c) make provision in relation to vehicle entry into the Yarra Park Reserve.

#### **3. Authorising provision**

This Order is made under section 3 of the **Melbourne Cricket Ground Act 1984**.

#### **4. Floodlights may be used on certain days at certain times and for certain purposes**

The floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground may be used for the purpose –
