The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment SL12 to all Victorian Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment makes minor changes to the Special Use – Port Areas Zone at Clause 6Q in the State Section of the Planning Scheme and inserts new local planning policy and controls for the Webb Dock Precinct at Clause 120 of the Local Section of the Port of Melbourne Planning Scheme. The planning scheme maps are amended to include in the Port of Melbourne Planning Scheme an area of approximately 50 metres width from the Docklands Zone in the Melbourne Planning Scheme.
