Health Services Act 1988

AN ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 8(1), 33(7), 34(1) AND 65 OF THE **HEALTH SERVICES ACT 1988** (THE ACT) IN RELATION TO THE AMALGAMATION OF COLERAINE AND DISTRICT HOSPITAL, COLERAINE AND DISTRICT HOMES FOR THE AGED INC AND MERINO HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO BE KNOWN AS COLERAINE DISTRICT HEALTH SERVICES

THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL by this Order –

1. **Directs**, under section 65(1) of the Act, that Coleraine and District Hospital, Coleraine and District Homes for the Aged Inc. and Merino Health Services be amalgamated.
2. **Declares**, under section 65(4) of the Act, that the new registered funded agency named Coleraine District Health Services shall be a Schedule 1 public hospital under the Act.
3. **Appoints**, under section 33(7) and 34(1) the initial board of management of the new registered funded agency, Coleraine District Health Services, to be constituted as specified in the table below:
