#### QUEENSLIFFE PLANNING SCHEME

##### Notice of Approval of Amendment

##### Amendment C7

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C7 to the Queenscliffe Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment implements the recommendations of the Borough of Queenscliffe Urban Character Study 2000. It changes the Municipal Strategic Statement, amends Local Planning Policy – Heritage (Clause 22.03) and introduces a new Local Policy – Urban Character (Clause 22.04). The Amendment replaces the existing four Design and Development Overlay Schedules with six new Design and Development Overlay Schedules. It also replaces the existing Vegetation Protection Overlay Schedules 1 and 2 with a new Schedule 1.

### Food Act 1984

#### SECTION 19K

##### Declaration of Audit Intervals for Declared Classes of Food Premises

I, Jennifer McDonald, delegate to the Secretary to the Department of Human Services, acting under section 19K of the **Food Act 1984** declare that-

1. Class 1 food premises, as declared under section 19C of the **Food Act 1984**, are to have a food safety program audit conducted

at an interval of not more than 6 months from 2 January 2002 and then not more than an interval of 12 months between each audit thereafter; and

- Class 2 food premises, as declared under section 19C of the **Food Act 1984**, are to have a food safety program audit conducted at an interval of not more than 12 months from the first registration or renewal of registration after 2 January 2002 and then not more than an interval of 12 months between each audit thereafter.

This declaration takes effect on 2 January 2002.

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**Food Act 1984**

EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 19V

I, Jennifer McDonald, delegate to the Secretary to the Department of Human Services, acting under section 19V of the **Food Act 1984** (“the Act”) exempt proprietors of Class 2 declared food premises that are seafood processors, seafood wholesalers and Class 2 declared food premises selling fresh seafood excluding:

- proprietors of supermarkets; and
- proprietors of food premises which predominantly retail cooked seafood;

from:

- the requirement in section 19E of the Act to have a food safety program; and
- the requirement in section 19GA of the Act to have a food safety supervisor

for the period up to and including 1 January 2003.

This exemption takes effect on 2 January 2002.

**Food Act 1984**

EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 19V

I, Jennifer McDonald, delegate to the Secretary to the Department of Human Services, acting under section 19V(ca) of the **Food Act 1984** (“the Act”) exempt proprietors of Class 1 and Class 2 declared food premises from the requirement in section 19GA of the Act to have a food safety supervisor for the period up to and including 30 June 2002.
