MELBOURNE CRICKET GROUND (OPERATION OF FLOODLIGHTS) ORDER NO. 2/2001

I, Sherryl Garbutt, Minister for Environment and Conservation, make the following Order:

1. *Title*

This Order may be cited as the Melbourne Cricket Ground (Operation of Floodlights) order No. 2/2001.

2. *Objectives*

The objectives of this Order are to —

- (a) specify the days and times during which the floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground may be used; and
- (b) specify the purposes for which the floodlights may be used on those days; and
- (c) make provision in relation to vehicle entry into the Yarra Park Reserve.

3. *Authorising provision*

This Order is made under section 3 of the **Melbourne Cricket Ground Act 1984**.

4. *Floodlights may be used on certain days at certain times and for certain purposes*

The floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground may be used —

- (a) for the purpose of playing Australian Football League matches on the following days between 8.30 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. for day matches and between 4.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. for night matches —

- (b) between 8 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. for the purpose of aligning, testing or repairing the floodlights on any day until 1 September 2001.

5. Yarra Park Reserve – Entry of Vehicles

Vehicular traffic is not permitted to enter into the Yarra Park Reserve by way of Vale Street after 5.00 p.m. on any day on which the floodlights affixed to the floodlight towers at the Melbourne Cricket Ground are permitted to be used for the purpose specified in clause 4(a).
