Road Safety Act 1986

ORDER AS TO DECLARED DRUGS

I, Peter Batchelor, acting under section 3 of the **Road Safety Act 1986**, by this Order—

- (a) revoke the Order as to Declared Drugs made on 25 November 1987 and published in the Government Gazette No G47 on 2 December 1987 (pp. 3252 – 3255); and
- (b) declare—
- each of the substances specified in the Schedule to this Order; and
 - any natural principle, any natural or synthetic derivative, any salt and any compound of those substances; and
 - any preparation or admixture of those substances, active principles, salts or compounds; and
 - any substance included in a class of drug specified in the Schedule to this Order; and
 - any deleterious substance as defined by section 57 of the **Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981**—

to be a drug for the purposes of that Act.
