GREATER DANDENONG CITY COUNCIL  
Order under Section 26(2) of the **Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994**

Council gives notice that, in the exercise of its powers under Section 26(2) of the **Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994**, the

Council made the following order at its meeting on 27 August 2001.

- A Unless the public place is an off-lead area, a dog in a public place must at all times be restrained by its owner by means of a chain, cord or lead.
- B A dog in an off-lead area need not be restrained by a chain, cord or leash provided the dog is at all times under the effective control of its owner.
- C Dogs are prohibited from entering or remaining in a prohibited area of the municipal district, whether restrained or otherwise.
- D For the purposes of this order:
  - (i) an off-lead area is an area described in Schedule 1 or is an area of the municipal district which is specified as such by a Council resolution for the purpose of this order and designated by signs in or adjacent to the area.
  - (ii) public place has the same meaning as "public place" in the **Summary Offences Act 1966**.
  - (iii) owner has the same meaning as "owner" in the **Domestic (Feral and Nuisance) Animals Act 1994**.
  - (iv) a dog is only under the effective control of its owner if the dog will return to its owner upon command and if the owner has a clear and unobstructed view of the dog.
  - (v) a prohibited area is an area described in Schedule 2 or is an area of the municipal district which is specified as such by a Council resolution for the purpose of this order and designated by signs in or adjacent to the area.

This order takes effect when it is published in the Government Gazette and in a newspaper circulating in the municipal district.

- (iii) Part 4 of the Local Law contains provisions relating to the applying for, issuing, cancellation and the keeping of a register of permits, the issuing of Notices to Comply and action that may be taken in urgent circumstances, infringement notices and payment of penalties, and exemptions and dispensation.

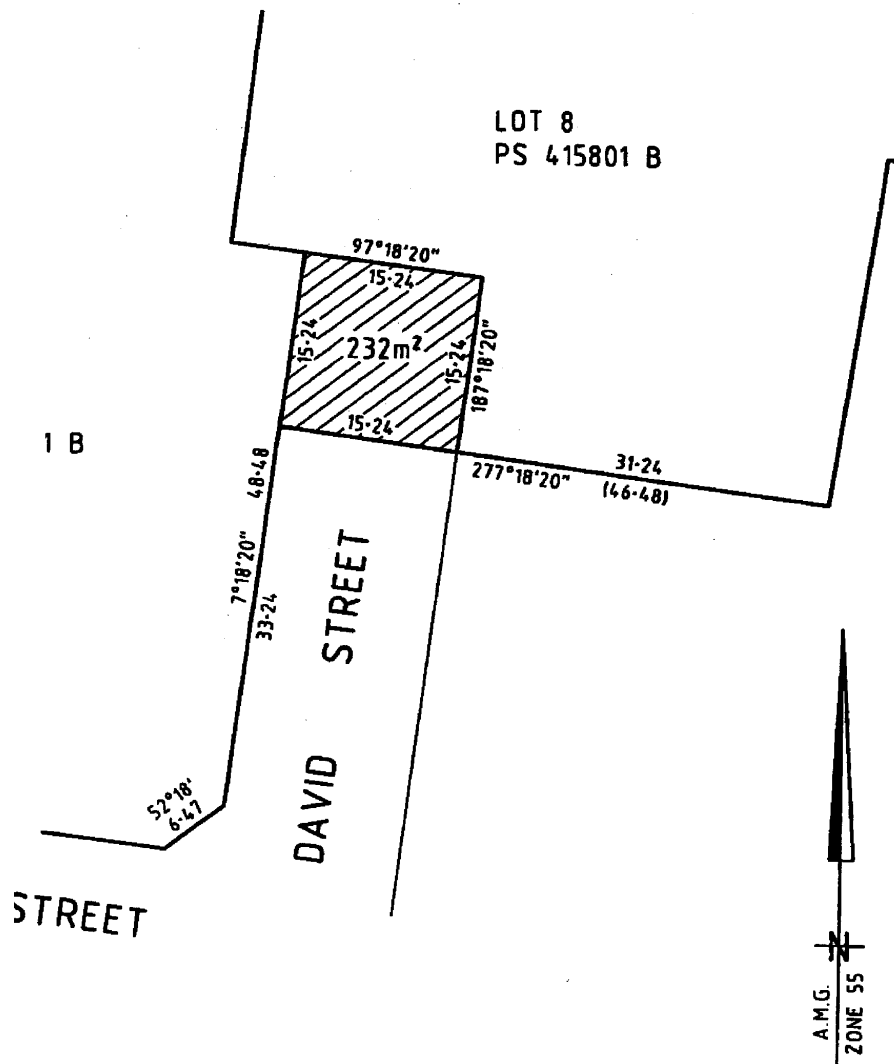

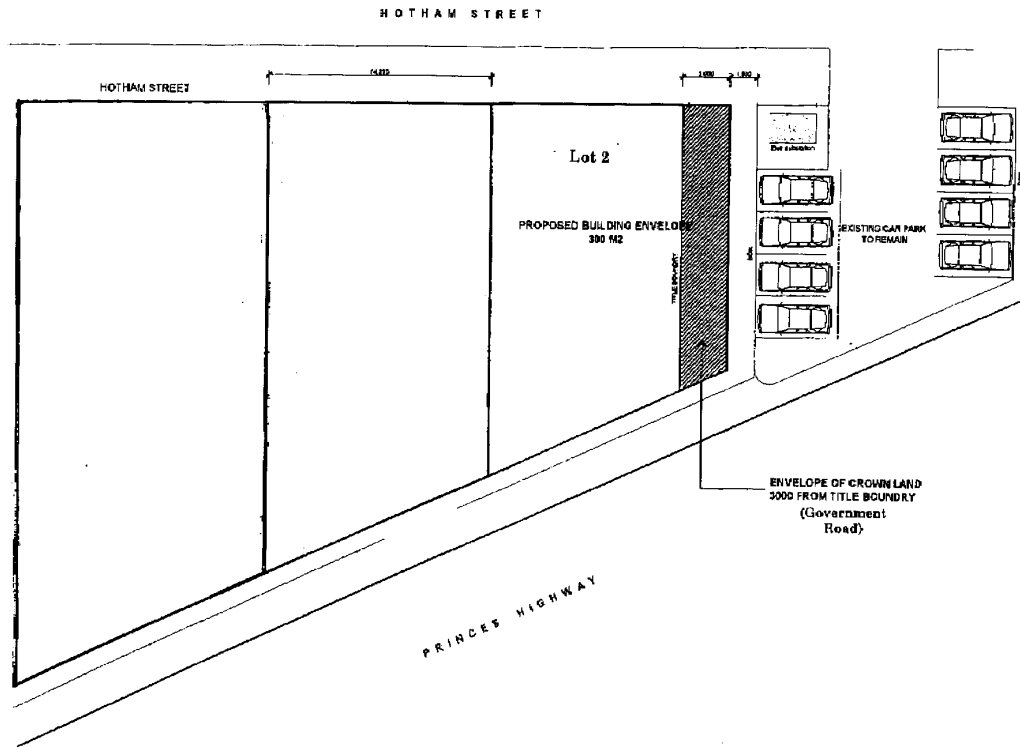

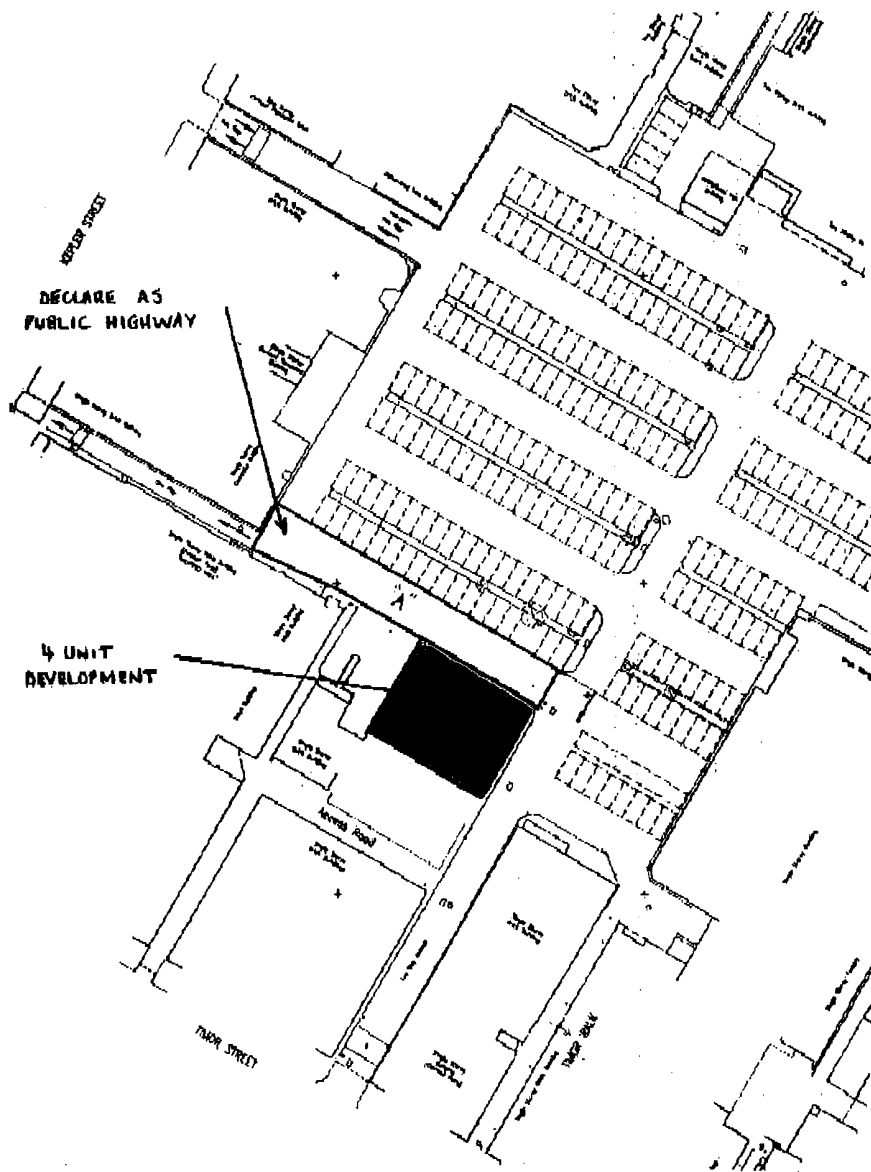

The site is located on the southern side of Burwood Highway, Vermont South opposite the intersection of Burwood Highway and Morack Road. The site is currently occupied by a Golf Driving Range. The subject site is rectangular in shape and is generally flat, except for the embankment along the eastern boundary. The site contains an area of 5.69 hectares.

The land subject to the rezoning request and the permit application slightly differ. The land subject to the rezoning request relates to 606–634 Burwood Highway (Golf Driving Range land) and a strip of land on the northern side of the Waste Transfer Station which is currently in a Residential 1 Zone.

- The service wishes to provide residents with a staff member of the same sex when there is a necessity to teach and provide support in matters of personal and intimate physical care, the staff member being a person with whom the residents feel they have a safe and comfortable relationship; and
- When away on camping trips as a part of the Electra Street program, it is essential that there be a female staff member who can discretely supervise the female residents when they are using public ablution blocks, and to ensure appropriate behaviour and safety for both the residents and other members of the public.
