### **WHITTLESEA PLANNING SCHEME**

#### **Notice of Approval of Amendment**

##### **Amendment C23**

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C23 to the Whittlesea Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment applies a Public Acquisition Overlay to land required for the future route of the Hume Freeway link between the Hume Highway north of Craigieburn and the Metropolitan Ring Road. The existing Public Acquisition Overlay is deleted from the former freeway reservation and the zoning of that route corrected to a Public Use Zone and a Public Conservation and Resource Zone. Land within the National Estate is covered by an Environmental Significance Overlay (where none currently exists).

A Design and Development Overlay and associated schedule is introduced over land each side of the proposed route to require noise attenuation measures to be incorporated within specified types of new development.

Land within the route alignment is exempted from the provisions of the Environmental Significance Overlay 2, the Land Subject to Inundation Overlay, the Floodway Overlay and the clause relating to clearance of native vegetation.

#### **Notice of Approval of Amendment**

##### **Amendment C22**

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C22 to the Hume Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.
